

CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 468

A BY-LAW to acquire lands within the Municipality of Burnaby.

WHEREAS under the provisions of Sub-section 27 of Section 54 of the "Municipal Act" the Municipal Council is authorised to make and pass By-laws to acquire lands:

AND WHEREAS it is desirable and expedient that a Seventy two one-hundredths (.72) of an acre portion of Lot One (1), Block One (1) District Lot Fourteen (14) Group One (1) New Westminster District, Map 3047, should be acquired.

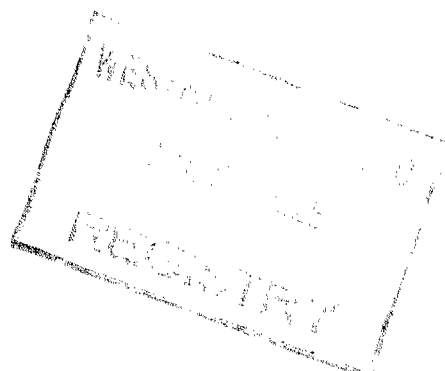
THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby enacts as follows:-

1. Portion of Lot One (1) Block One (1) D.L. Fourteen (14) Group One (1) Municipality of Burnaby, New Westminster District, more particularly known and described as follows:

Commencing at a post set on the Westerly boundary of Lot One (1) of Block One (1) District Lot Fourteen (14) Group One (1) New Westminster District, at a point Two hundred and sixty (260) feet N. 33° 59' West from the South West corner of said Block One (1); thence N. 56° 01' E. Forty (40) feet more or less, to a point on the Westerly bank of Brunette River; thence Northwardly and following the said Westerly bank of the Brunette River, Seven hundred and ten (710) feet more or less, to the North corner of said Lot One (1); thence Southwardly and following the Westerly boundary of said Lot One (1) Seven hundred and ten and fifty three one-hundredths (710.53) feet to the point of commencement and containing by admeasurement Seventy two one-hundredth (.72) of an acre, be the same more or less as shown on plan hereunto annexed and thereon outlined in red colour, shall be acquired from Matilda Jane Rowland of Buena Vista, in the Municipality of Burnaby, and Province of British Columbia, wife of George Rowland, of the same address, for Corporate purposes.

2. On execution and delivery of Conveyance of said parcel by the said Matilda Jane Rowland, Wife of George Rowland, of Buena Vista, Municipality of Burnaby, Province of British Columbia, to the Corporation of the District of Burnaby, she shall be paid the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar.

3. This By-law shall take effect upon its being finally passed.



4. This By-law may be cited as "MATILDA JANE ROWLAND  
PROPERTY BY-LAW 1925."

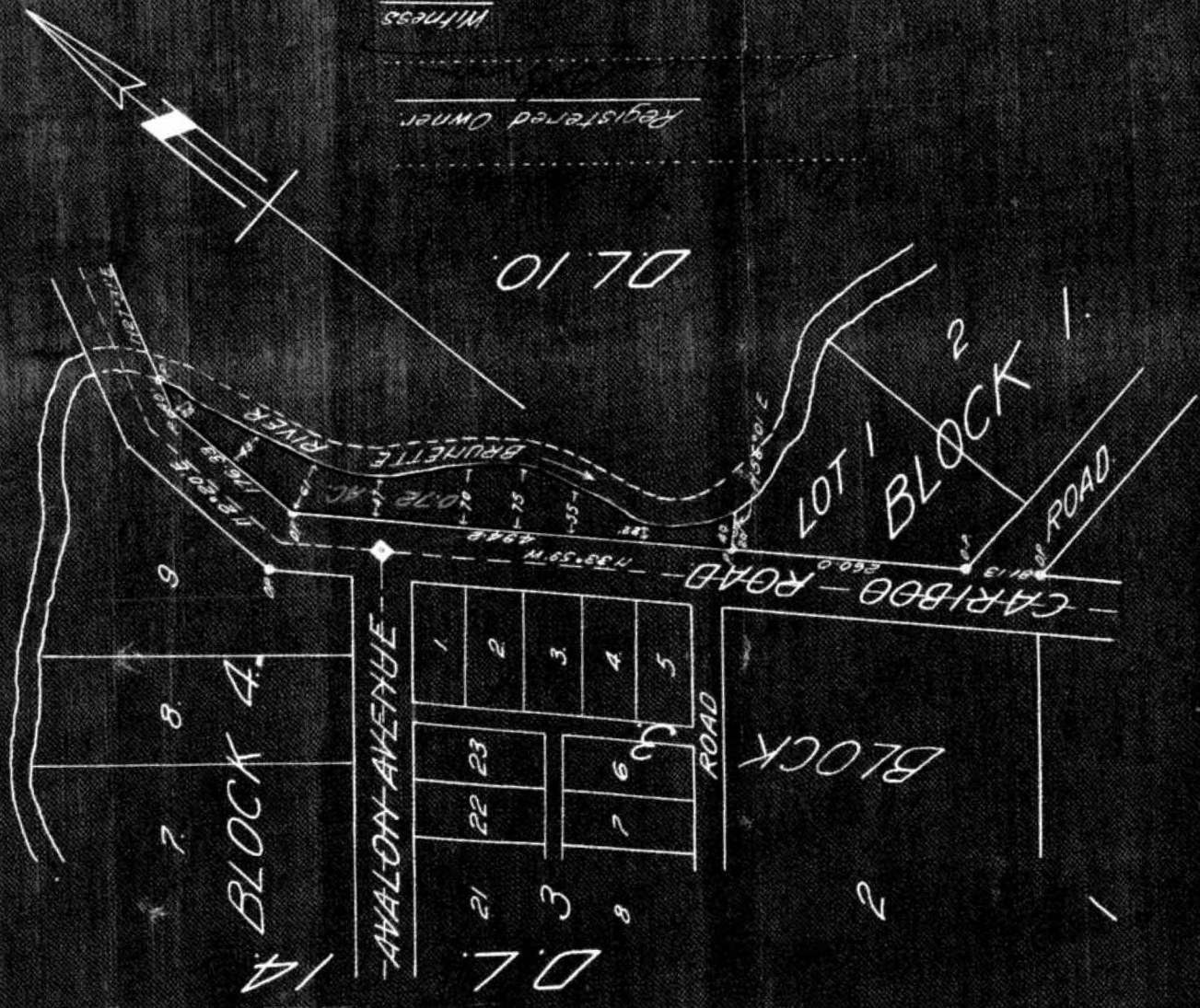
