CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 478.

A BY-LAW to amend the "Burnaby-Westminster Sewer Fund Diversion By-law, 1924." being By-law No. 449. of the Corporation.

WHEREAS By-law No. 449 of the Corporation entituled "Burnaby Westminster Sewer Fund Diversion By-law 1924" received the assent of the electors of the Municipality on the Seventeenth (17th) day of January, 1925.

AND WHEREAS the works authorised by the said By-law as detailed in Schedule "B" thereof can be finally completed for the sum of Twenty thousand eight hundred and forty nine (\$20,849.00) Dollars.

AND WHEREAS there is a surplus amounting to Four thousand one hundred and fifty one (\$4,151.00) Dollars arising out of the amount appropriated for sidewalks in clause one (1) of the said By-law;

AND WHEREAS it is desirable and expedient that the said sum of Four thousand One hundred and fifty one (\$4,151.00) dollars should be expended in the construction of further new sidewalks in the Municipality;

AND WHEREAS under the provisions of Sub-Section 2 of Section 176 of the Municipal Act any By-law to which the assent of the electors has been obtained may be altered or repealed by the assent of the Lieutenant-Governor-in-Council.

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby enacts as follows:-

1. Schedule "B" attached to the said By-law No. 449 is amended by adding thereto the schedule attached to this by-law.

2. Any surplus remaining after the construction of the new sidewalks set out in the schedule attached to this

By-law shall be applied to the cost of maintenance of sidewalks constructed under the By-law No. 449 and this By-law, and for no other purpose.

3. This By-law may be cited as the "Burnaby Westminster Sewer Fund Diversion By-law 1924, Amendment By-law 1925."

DONE AND PASSED in Open Council this Twenty eighth (28th) day of September, 1925.

RECONSIDERED and FINALLY PASSED this Fifth (5th) day of October, 1925.
