

CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 490.

A BY-LAW to amend the Waterworks Regulation
By-law, 1912.

The Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District
of Burnaby ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

1. Section 1 of The Burnaby Waterworks Regulation By-law,
1912 being By-law No. 134 of this Corporation is hereby amended
by inserting after the word, "rates", in the fourth line thereof
the words, "and discounts thereon".

2. Section 2 of said By-law No. 134 is hereby repealed.

3. Section 3 of said By-law No. 134 is hereby repealed
and the following substituted therefor:-

"3. All meter rates and rents (except such rent as may be paid
in advance) as the same shall be fixed from time to time by the
Council under the provisions of this By-law shall be due and
payable at the Municipal Collector's Office at the Municipal
Hall or to any person authorized by the Council to receive the
same, on the last day of the month following the month for which
the water may be used."

"All flat rates shall be due and payable at the Municipal
Collector's Office at the Municipal Hall or to any person author-
ized by the Council to receive the same, on such dates as the
Council may from time to time by resolution determine."

"Consumers paying flat rates or meter rates on or before the
dates herein specified shall be entitled to such discount as may
be determined by the Council under the provision of this By-law."

4. Section 4 of the said By-law No. 134 as re-enacted by
Section 1 of the "Burnaby Waterworks Regulation By-law, 1912,

Amendment By-law, 1924", is hereby repealed.

5. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY WATERWORKS
REGULATION BY-LAW, 1912, AMENDMENT BY-LAW, 1925".
