

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 499.

A BY-LAW to authorize the exchange of certain lands acquired by the Corporation under Tax Sale proceedings for certain other lands owned by Thomas J. Watson.

WHEREAS the Corporation has acquired under Tax Sale Proceedings the lands and premises known and described as Lot Nineteen (19) in Sub-division "F", Blocks Seven (7) and Eight (8) according to a plan of a sub-division of District Lot Eighty-eight (88) in Group One (1) New Westminster District, deposited in the Land Registry Office at New Westminster, British Columbia, as number 2390.

AND WHEREAS Thomas J Watson of the Municipality of Burnaby aforesaid is the registered owner of the lands and premises known and described as Lot Five (5) in Block Thirty-five (35) according to a plan of a sub-division of District Lot Thirteen (13) in Group One (1) in said New Westminster District deposited in the said Land Registry Office as number 3046.

AND WHEREAS the said Thomas J Watson has requested the Corporation to convey to him the said lands so acquired by the Corporation under Tax Sale Proceedings and to accept in full payment thereof a Conveyance of the said lands and premises owned by the said Thomas J. Watson.

AND WHEREAS the Council deems it expedient to effect such exchange of lands.

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

(1) Upon the execution and delivery to the Corporation by the said Thomas J. Watson of a good and sufficient Deed in Fee Simple of said Lot Five (5), free and clear of all encumbrances whatsoever the Reeve and

Clerk of the Corporation are hereby authorized and empowered to execute and set the official and corporate seal of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby to a Conveyance of said Lot Nineteen (19) to the said Thomas J. Watson and to deliver such Conveyance when so executed to the said Thomas J. Watson.

2. This By-law may be cited as the "THOMAS J. WATSON PROPERTY EXCHANGE BY-LAW 1926."

DONE AND PASSED in Open Council this Fifteenth (15th) day of February, 1926.

RECONSIDERED and FINALLY PASSED by an affirmative vote of three-fourths of all the members of the Council this First (1st) day of March, 1926.
