

CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 504.

A BY-LAW to acquire lands within the Municipality of Burnaby for Corporate purposes.

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WHEREAS under the provisions of Sub-section 27 of Section 54 of the "Municipal Act" the Municipal Council is authorised to make and pass By-laws to acquire lands:

AND WHEREAS it is desirable and expedient that the northerly thirty-three feet strip of Parcel "B" of District Lot Sixty eight (68), Group One (1) New Westminster District, as shown on the plan hereunte annexed and thereon outlined in red colour, should be acquired.

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby enacts as follows:-

1. That portion of Parcel "B" District Lot Sixty-eight (68) Group One (1) District of New Westminster, Province of British Columbia, and being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at an iron pin set on the North Boundary of Lot Sixty eight (68) Group One (1) New Westminster District, at a point Six hundred and seventy eight and five-tenths (678.5) feet N.89° 28' W. from the Northeast corner of said Lot Sixty eight (68), said point being the Northeast corner of Parcel "B" aforesaid; thence N.89° 28' W. and following the North Boundary of Lot Sixty eight (68) aforesaid, Six hundred and eighty and forty-five one hundredths (680.45) feet to an iron pin set on the Northerly production of the East boundary of that portion of District Lot Sixty eight (68) as subdivided under Plan 980, deposited; thence S 0° 21' 30" W. Thirty three (33) feet to the Northeast corner of Block Two (2) of that portion of District Lot Sixty eight (68), Group One (1) as subdivided under Plan 980, deposited; thence

S. $89^{\circ} 28'$ E and parallel to the North Boundary of Lot Sixty eight (68) aforesaid, Six hundred and eighty and three one-hundredths (680.03) feet to an iron pin set on the East Boundary of Parcel "B" aforesaid; thence N $1^{\circ} 05' 30''$ E and following the East boundary of said Parcel "B" Thirty-three (33) feet to the point of commencement, and containing by admeasurement five hundred and fifteen one-thousandths (0.515) of an Acre, be the same more or less, as shown on the plan hereunto annexed and thereon outlined in red colour, shall be acquired from Francis James Mayers (Teacher) and Nina Pearl Mayers, wife of Francis James Mayers, both of 8226 Granville Street, in the Municipality of Point Grey, Province of British Columbia, for Corporate purposes.

2. On execution and delivery of Conveyances of the said parcel by the said Francis James Mayers and Nina Pearl Mayers to the Corporation of the District of Burnaby, they shall be paid the sum of Two hundred and six (\$206.00) dollars.

3. This By-law shall take effect upon its being finally passed.

4. This By-law may be cited as the "F.J.MAYERS PROPERTY PURCHASE BY-LAW 1926."
