

CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 505.

A BY-LAW to acquire lands within the
Municipality of Burnaby.

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WHEREAS under the provisions of Sub-section 27
of Section 54 of the "Municipal Act" the Municipal
Council is authorized to make and pass By-laws to
acquire lands:

AND WHEREAS it is desirable and expedient that
Lot "B" of Lot Two (2) of Block Two (2) of Lot One
hundred and fifty eight (158) Group One (1) Map 3423,
New Westminster District, should be acquired.

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation
of the District of Burnaby enacts as follows:-

1. Lot "B" of Lot Two (2) of Block Two (2) of
Lot One hundred and fifty eight (158) Group (1) One,
Map 3423 in the District of New Westminster, Province
of British Columbia shall be acquired from Thomas
James Elmore, of 1604 Royal Oak Avenue, in the
Municipality of Burnaby, Province of British Columbia,
(Mechanic) for Corporate purposes.

2. On executing and delivery of Conveyance
of the said parcel by the said Thomas James Elmore,
(Mechanic) of 1604 Royal Oak Avenue, in the Municipal-
ity of Burnaby and Province of British Columbia, to the
Corporation of the District of Burnaby, he shall be
paid the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar.

3. This By-law shall take effect upon its being finally passed.

4. This By-law may be cited as "THOMAS J. ELMORE PROPERTY PURCHASE BY-LAW 1926."
