

CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 520.

A BY-LAW for altering the names of certain streets and giving names to certain other streets in the Municipality of Burnaby

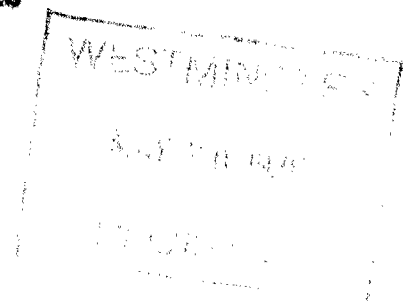
THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:-

1. The name "Grandview Highway" is hereby given and designated as the title of the highway more particularly described as follows, that is to say:-

Commencing at a point on Boundary Road between Dominion Street and Norfolk Street; thence on a curve in a South Easterly direction to Schou Street, thence following the line of Schou Street in an Easterly direction to a point between Westminster Avenue and Royal Oak Avenue thence on a curve in a south easterly direction to Royal Oak Avenue; thence following the line of Royal Oak Avenue in a southerly direction to a point between Harwood Street and Woodland Street; thence on a curve in a south easterly direction to Sprott Street; thence following the line of Sprott Street in an Easterly direction to a point West of Douglas Road; thence on a curve in a South Easterly direction to an intersection with Douglas Road.

2. The names of those portions of certain streets mentioned in the foregoing description are hereby altered and are hereby designated as portions of the said "Grandview Highway", that is to say:-

- (a) Portion of Schou Street
- (b) Portion of Royal Oak Avenue
- (c) Portion of Sprott Street



3. This By-law may be cited as the "Burnaby Street Naming By-law 1926"
