BY-LAW NO. 537.

A BY-LAW to amend the "Burnaby Sewer Connections Regulation By-law 1926."

- - - -

THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

1. Section Two (2) of the "Burnaby Sewer Connections Regulation By-law 1926" is hereby repealed and the following substituted therefor:

"2. Before any such connection is made, application must be made by the owner, to the Municipal Engineer in the form of Schedule "A" of this By-law and there shall be paid with each application for a connection with a sewer in a lane, a fee of Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00) and with each application for a connection with a sewer in a street there shall be paid a fee of Twenty five Dollars (\$25.00)."

2. This By-law shall take effect upon the day and date of registration hereof.

3. This By-law may be cited as the "Burnaby Sewer Connections Regulation By-law 1926, Amendment By-law 1926."
