

Burnaby (School Board) Revenue Bye Law 1906.

A Bye Law to provide for the raising of Revenue for the general purposes of the Board of School Trustees of Burnaby in District Lot 172 (extra Municipal).

Whereas by the Public Schools Act 1905 Amendment Act 1906 the Council of any City Town or Rural Municipality in the Province are empowered in each and every year pass a Bye law or Bye Laws for levying a special rate of not more than five mills on the dollar for school purposes

And whereas the Council of Public Instruction are empowered under the said Public Schools Act to create new School districts in addition to those already in existence and to define the boundaries thereof also to alter and define the boundaries of existing districts from time to time and to cancel the creation of school districts

And whereas the Council of Public Instruction by an Order dated the 14<sup>th</sup> day of March, 1906 included in the boundaries of Burnaby Municipality for School purposes the whole of District Lot 172

Be it therefore enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township or District Municipality of Burnaby pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Clauses Act and the Public Schools Act 1905 Amendment Act 1906

There shall be raised levied and collected for the year 1906 upon the assessed value of all wild and Improved taxable real property in District Lot 172 as shown upon the last revised Assessment Roll thereof all improvements being exempt altogether a tax of Two and One half Mills on the Dollar for the purposes of

~~the School Trustees of Burnaby. x~~

The said taxes shall be payable to the collector at the Municipal Hall Burnaby, and on or before the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of October 1906

All owners of property liable to pay this tax shall pay the same when due. All taxes unpaid on the thirty-first day of December in each year are in arrear. All owners of property on, or in respect of which taxes are in arrear shall pay an additional rate of Eight per cent on all such arrears for each and every year or portion of a year during which such taxes were or shall be in arrear.

This Bye-Law may be cited for all purposes as the "Burnaby School Board (Extra Municipal) Revenue Bye Law 1906."
