CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY.

BY-LAW NO. 567.

A By-law for constructing, operating, and maintaining extensions to the water works in the Municipality.

.....

WHEREAS by sub-section (24) of Section 54 of the Municipal Act it is provided that in every Municipality the Council may from time to time make, alter, and repeal bylaws not inconsistent with any law in force in the province for purchasing, constructing, operating, and maintaining works for supplying, for any and all purposes, water, water-power, electric light, electric power, and gas to the inhabitants of the municipality and of localities adjacent thereto, and for regulating the rates, conditions, and terms under or upon which the same may be supplied and used: Provided, however, that no Bylaw passed under the provisions of this clause shall come into force until approved by the Lieutenant-Governor in Council.

AND WHEREAS under the authority of the said Act the Corporation has constructed and has been and is operating works for supplying water to the inhabitants of certain portions of the Municipality.

AND WHEREAS it is expedient to extend the said works and to operate and maintain the said works and extensions.

The Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

1. It shall be lawful for the Council from time to time to construct extensions or additions to the said works in the whole or any portion or portions of the Municipality for supplying water to other inhabitants of the Municipality, and to alter, reconstruct, improve, repair, maintain, and operate the said works heretofore constructed as well as the said extensions and additions.

2. This Bylaw shall not come into force until approved by the Lieutenant-Governor in Council.

3. This Bylaw before the final passing thereof shall receive the assent of the Electors of the said Municipality in manner required by law.

4. This Bylaw shall take effect on the registration thereof as provided in Section 178 of the Municipal Act.

5. This Bylaw may be cited as the "BURNABY WATER WORKS GENERAL AUTHORIZATION BYLAW 1926."
