

CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 574

A BY-LAW to authorise the Corporation of the District of Burnaby to acquire an Easement for Corporate purposes.

WHEREAS it is desirable and expedient that an Easement should be acquired for drainage purposes across the lands described as a portion of Lots Four (4) Five (5) Six (6) Seven (7) and Eight (8) of Block One (1) in the subdivision of Lot Two hundred and seven (207) Group One (1) Map 4032.

AND WHEREAS Harry R Fullerton is the owner in fee of the said lands:

AND WHEREAS under the provisions of sub-section 30 paragraph "A" of Section 54 of the "Municipal Act", the Municipal Council is authorized to make and pass a by-law to acquire lands:

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby enacts as follows:

1. It shall be lawful for the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby to acquire an Easement from Harry R Fullerton, of 553 Granville Street, in the City of Vancouver, Province of British Columbia, for drainage purposes across a portion of Lots Four (4), Five (5), Six (6), Seven (7) and Eight (8) of Block One (1) in the subdivision of Lot Two hundred and seven (207) Group One (1) New Westminster District, Map 4032, which parcel may be more particularly described as follows:-

Seven and one-half feet (7.5') on each side of the following described centre line:-

Commencing at the Southwest corner of said Lot Seven (7) thence North Nineteen degrees Thirty one minutes East ($19^{\circ}31'E$) One hundred and forty five (145) feet to the Northeast corner of said Lot seven (7);

Thence North Fourteen degrees and sixteen minutes East ($N14^{\circ}16'E$) One hundred and sixty feet (160');

Thence North Thirty nine degrees and fifty five minutes West ($N39^{\circ}55'W$) One hundred and eleven (111) feet;

Thence South Eighty one degrees and fifteen minutes West ($S81^{\circ}15'W$) Sixty three and ninety four one-hundredths (63.94) feet more or less to an intersection with the west boundary of said Lot Four (4) as shown coloured red on the Map or plan hereto attached, and containing in area Sixteen one hundredths (.16) of one acre, more or less

Paying therefor the sum of One (\$1.00) dollar of lawful money of Canada.

2. This By-law may be cited as the "D.L.207 Easement By-law 1927".

DONE AND PASSED in Open Council this Seventh (7th) day of March 1927.



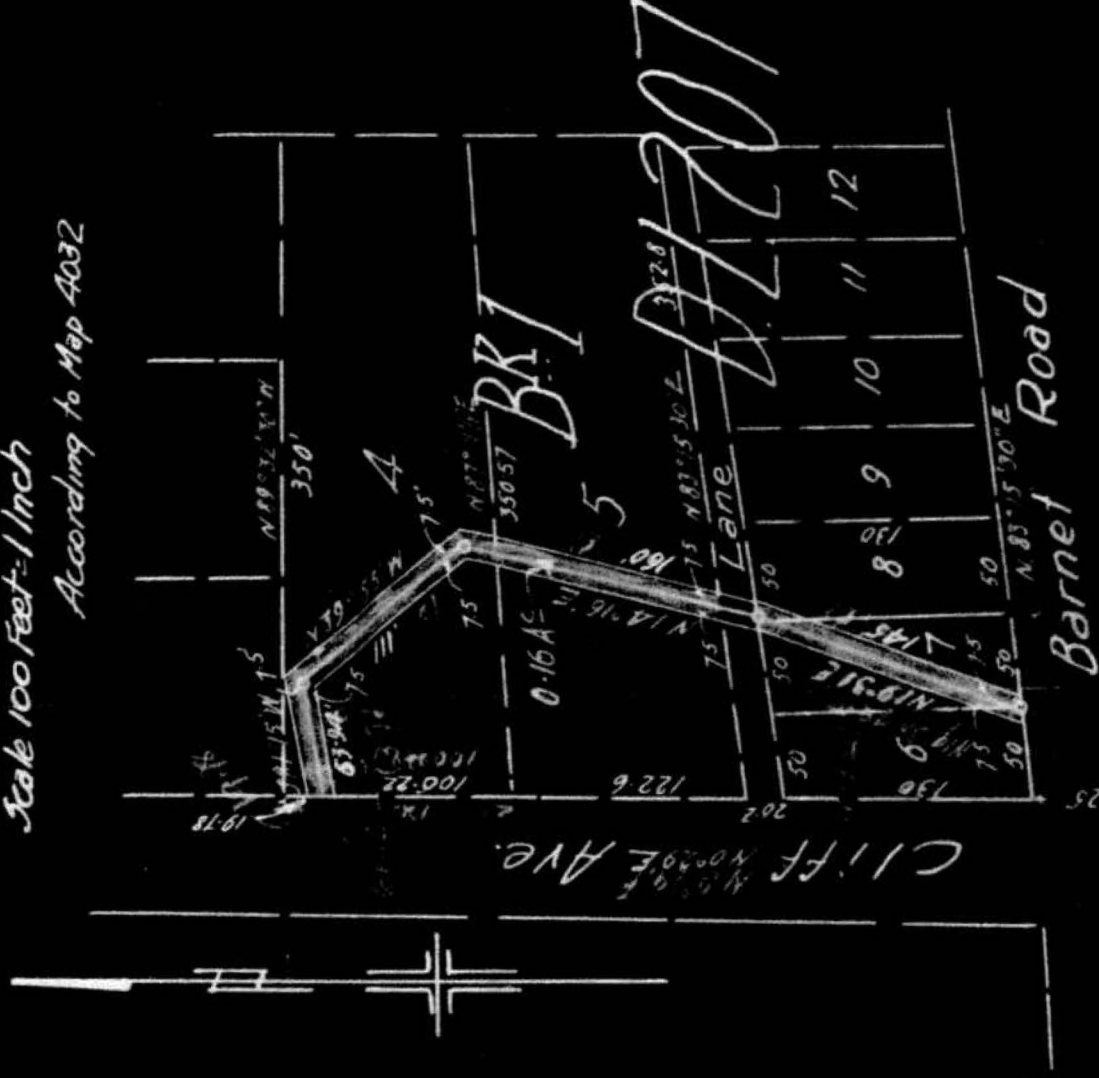
