

CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 583

A BY-LAW to amend the Burnaby Health By-law
1926.

- - - - -

THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL of the Corporation of the
District of Burnaby, HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Burnaby Health By-law 1926 being By-law
No. 509 of the Corporation is hereby amended by adding
as Section 12a thereof the following:

12a. In the case of transient tourists' camp
grounds the following regulations shall apply:-

(1) Tourist camp grounds where used in this By-law
shall include and mean any tract or parcel of land owned,
maintained or used for public camping, upon which tract
or parcel of land persons may camp either free of charge
or by the payment of a fee.

(2) There shall not be more than sixteen cabins
for each six thousand square feet of land, erected on any
tourist camp ground.

(3) If there should be more than one cabin erected
on any area of six thousand square feet of land used as a
tourist camp ground, only one of such cabins so erected
on such area may be occupied by any person or persons as
tenant or otherwise from the 1st day of November in one
year till the 30th day of April in the following year.

(4) There shall be at least one toilet for men and
one toilet for women for each six thousand square feet
of land or for each sixteen cabins.

(5) Each one-roomed cabin shall have not less than
five hundred cubic feet of air space for each person

occupying the same."

2. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY HEALTH BY-LAW 1926 AMENDMENT BY-LAW 1927".
