BY-LAW NO. 589.

A By-law to provide Group Life Insurance for employees of the Corporation.

..

WHEREAS under sub-section 253(b) of Section 54 of the Municipal Act as amended by Section 18 of the Municipal Act Amendment Act 1927, the Corporation is authorized to contribute or pay the full amount or any portion of any premium or premiums in respect of any benefit, accident or sickness or life insurance policy or policies or scheme of group insurance for the purpose of insuring all or any employees of the Corporation against sickness, accident or death as the case may be:

AND WHIREAS in the opinion of the Council it is expedient to provide group insurance for its employees;

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

1. Authority is hereby given to the Reeve and Clerk of the Corporation to enter into a contract with the London Life Insurance Company of London, Canada, or with any other Life Insurance Company that may be selected by resolution of the Council to provide group insurance for the employees of the Corporation. Any such contract of insurance may be upon the same terms and conditions as are set out in a certain group insurance contract numbered G. 231 offered to the Corporation by the London Life Insurance Company on December 7th 1927 and the rates of insurance and premiums of insurance based on any such contract are to be adjusted as of the 7th day of June 1927.
