## THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BUICKARY

BY-LAW NO. 590.

A BY-LAW to authorize the Construction of Severs in certain streets in the Municipality of Burnaby hereinafter mentioned, as Local Improvements under the provisions of the "Local Improvement Act".

whereas notice of the intention of the Council to undertake the construction, as a Local Improvement, of the work hereinafter described has been duly given by publication of the notice and by service of it upon the owners of the lots liable to be specially assessed, and the publication and service of such notice has been proved by a statutory declaration filed with the Clerk, and no petition against the work signed by a majority of the owners, representing at least one-half the value of the lots which are liable to be specially assessed, has been presented:

AND WHEREAS the Provincial Board of Realth has issued a provisional cortificate of approval of the said Sewer Construction work dated the 10th day of January, A.D. 1927 and it is therefore necessary and desirable in the public interest, on sanitary grounds, to construct such sewers in accordance with plans so approved by the Provincial Board of Health:

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

- 1. That a newer be constructed in each of the following streets of the Municipality, that is to say:

- (69). In Lots 1, 2, and 3, of Block 37, D.L. 153, Five (5') feet North of the South Boundary, from Mayne Avenue to Cassie Avenue.
- (70). In Telfer Avenue from Trafalgar Street to British Columbia Electric Railway.
- That the Engineers of the Corporation, do forthwith make such plans, profiles, and specifications and furnish such information as may be necessary for the making of a contract for the execution of the work.
- The work shall be carried on and executed under the superintendence and according to the directions and orders of

such Mgineers.

- 4. The Reeve and Clerk are authorized to cause a contract for the construction of the work to be made and entered into with some person or persons, firm or corporation, subject to the approval of this Council to be declared by resolution.
- 5. The Treasurer may (subject to the approval of the Council) agree with any bank or person for temperary advances of money to meet the cost of the work pending the completion of it.
- 6. The special assessment shall be paid by thirty (30) annual instalments.
- 7. The debentures to be issued for the lean to be effected to pay for the cost of the work when completed shall bear interest at five (5%) per cent. per annum, and be made payable within thirty (30) years on the sinking fund plan, and in settling the sum to be raised annually to pay the debt the rate of interest on investments shall not be estimated at more than four (4%) per cent. per annum.
- commute for a payment in each the special rates imposed thereon, by paying the portion of the cost of construction assessed upon such lot, without the interest, forthwith after the special assessment roll has been certified by the Clerk, and at any time thereafter by the payment of such sum as when invested at not more than four (4%) per cent, per annum will provide an annuity sufficient to pay the special rates for the unexpired portion of the terms as they fall due.
  - 9. This By-law may be cited as "LOCAL IMPROVEMENT

CONSTRUCTION BY-LAW (WEST BURNARY SEWERS), 1987."
