

CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 595

A BY-LAW to dedicate certain street allowances within the Municipality of Burnaby

WHEREAS under the provisions of Sub-section 212 of Section 54 of the "Municipal Act" being chapter 179 of the Revised Statutes of British Columbia, 1924, the Municipal Council is authorised to make By-laws for establishing, opening, making, preserving, improving, repairing, widening, altering, diverting or stopping up roads, streets, squares, alleys, lanes, bridges or other public thoroughfares.

AND WHEREAS it is desirable and expedient that certain lands should be dedicated for the purpose of street allowances in the Municipality of Burnaby.

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. That the following parcels of lands shall be and are hereby dedicated for street purposes, that is to say:-
 - (a) Portion of Block One (1) District Lot Two hundred and fifteen (215) Group One (1) District of New Westminster, Province of British Columbia, according to Map 3082 deposited and being more particularly described as follows:
Commencing at the North west corner of Block 1 aforesaid; thence S 83° 07' E and following the Northerly boundary of said Block 1 and the Southerly boundary of the Barnet Road, 627.17 feet to an iron pin ; thence S 72° 10' 30" W, 480.7 feet; thence N 57° 00' W, 200.0 feet to an iron pin set on the West boundary of Block 1 aforesaid; thence N 1° 21' 30" E and following the West Boundary of Block 1 aforesaid, 113.4 feet, to the point of commencement, and containing by admeasurement, 1.67 acres, be the same more or less, as shown on the plan hereunto annexed and thereon outlined in red colour.
 - (b) The South thirty-three (33) feet of Lot Forty-eight (48) of part of Lot Ninety eight (98) Group One (1) Map 573, in the District of New Westminster.

2. This By-law shall take effect upon its being finally passed.

3. This By-law may be cited as the "Burnaby Streets
Dedication By-law 1927"

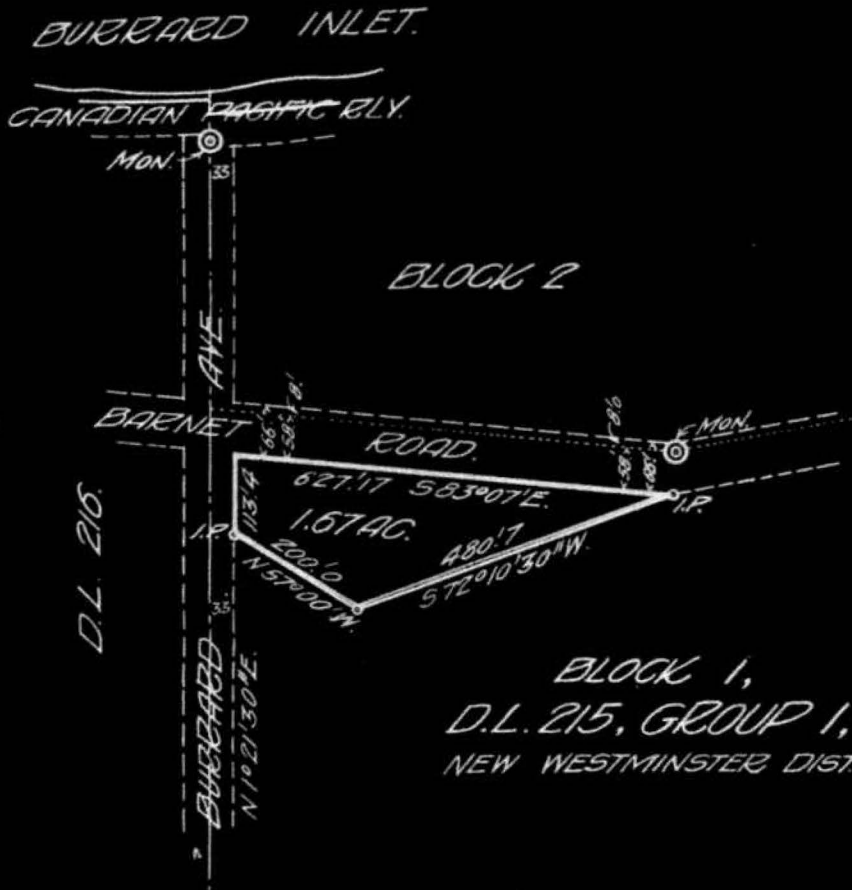
