



CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY.

## BY-LAW NO.599.

A By-law to authorize the Municipal Council to provide for the superannuation of employees of the Corporation under the provisions of the Superannuation Act and Amending Acts.

WHEREAS by Section 43 of the "Superannuation Act" as enacted by Section 20, Chapter 68, of the Statutes of British Columbia 1926-7, it is provided that every municipality shall upon application in writing from seventy-five per centum of all its employees, or of the employees within any one or more groups of its permanent employees, enter into an agreement with its employees or with such group or groups, as the case may be, in the manner prescribed by the regulations, for the purpose of securing the benefits of the said Act; and shall adopt the provisions of part 3 of the said Act and shall pay from its revenues all contributions required by the said Act from it as an employer;

AND WHEREAS the Corporation has received an application in writing from seventy-five per centum of all its employees requesting that the Corporation enter into an agreement with its employees for the purpose of securing the benefits of the said Act for such employees.

AND WHEREAS the Council deems it expedient to secure the benefits of the "Superannuation Act" for all the employees of the Corporation;

THERRFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

. 1. The Reeve and Clerk are hereby authorized to sign an agreement between the Corporation and its employees for the purpose of securing for such employees the benefits of the "<sup>5</sup>uperannuation Act" being Chapter 247 of the Revised Statutes of British Columbia 1924, and to affix the seal of the Corporation to such agreement, and to file the same with the Civil Service Commission of the Province of British Columbia pursuant to the said Act.

2. When such last mentioned agreement has been entered into pursuant to the provisions of the said "Superannuation Act" and of

this By-law, the Clerk of the Corporation shall file with the Civil Service Commission a notice signed by him stating that this Corporation has adopted the provisions of part 3 of the said Act to the end that those provisions shall thereafter apply to this Corporation and its employees.

3. This By-law may be cited for all purposes as the "BURNABY SUPERANNUATION BY-LAW 1927".
