

CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 601

A BY-LAW to authorise the Corporation of the District of Burnaby to accept a Quit claim deed to Lot 20, in a subdivision of District Lots 78 and 44, Group 1, New Westminster District, from John Harrison Muesse.

WHEREAS the Vancouver and Districts Joint Sewerage and Drainage Board, created under the "Vancouver & Districts Joint Sewerage and Drainage Act." being Chapter 79 of the Statutes of British Columbia, 1914, is desirous of changing the channel of Still Creek through Lots 20 and 9 of a subdivision of Lots 78 and 44, Group 1, New Westminster District.

AND WHEREAS ^{center} ~~the North and South banks of~~ Still Creek ^{A.B.M.} forms the boundary lines of the said Lots 20 and 9 respectively.

AND WHEREAS it is necessary for the purpose aforesaid to change the said boundary lines of the said Lots 20 and 9.

AND WHEREAS John Harrison Muesse is the owner in fee of Lot 9, District Lot 78 and 44, Group 1, New Westminster District.

AND WHEREAS the Corporation of the District of Burnaby is the owner in fee of Lot 20, District Lot 78 and 44, Group 1, New Westminster District.

AND WHEREAS it is desirable and expedient that the Corporation of the District of Burnaby should grant and quit claim all its Right, Title and Interest in Lot 9 in the subdivision of Lots 78 and 44, Group 1, New Westminster District, Map No. . to the said John Harrison Muesse, and that the Corporation of the District of Burnaby should accept a Quit claim from the said John Harrison Muesse of all his right, title and interest in the said Lot 20 in the subdivision of Lots 78 and 44, Group 1, New Westminster District. Map No. .

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. It shall be lawful for the Reeve and the Clerk to


accept from John Harrison Muesse a Quit Claim deed granting, releasing, and quit claiming all his right title, interest, claim and demand whatsoever in Lot Twenty (20) in District Lots Seventy-eight (78) and Forty four (44) Group One (1) New Westminster District, Map No. . and to pay therefor the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar.

2. This By-law may be cited as the "D.L.78.PROPERTY PURCHASE BY-LAW 1927."

DONE AND PASSED in Open Council this Eighteenth (18th) day of July, 1927.


