

CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 604.

A BY-LAW to acquire lands without the Municipality of Burnaby, for Corporate purposes.

WHEREAS under the provisions of sub-section 30 of Section 54 of the "Municipal Act" the Municipal Council is authorised to make and pass By-laws to acquire lands:

AND WHEREAS it is desirable and expedient that Lots Eleven (11) and Twelve (12), of Block Twenty seven (27) District Lot One hundred and Seventy two (172), Group One (1), New Westminster District, Map 453, should be acquired for the purpose of taking gravel therefrom.

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:-

(1). Lots Eleven (11) and Twelve (12) of Block Twenty-seven (27) District Lot One hundred and seventy-two (172) Group One (1) New Westminster District, in the Province of British Columbia, Map No. 453, shall be acquired from Frank James MacKenzie, of the Town of White Rock, in the Municipality of Surrey, in the Province of British Columbia, Real Estate Broker, for Corporate purposes.

(2). On execution and delivery of conveyance by the said Frank James MacKenzie, to the Corporation of the District of Burnaby, he shall be paid the sum of Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars.

(3). This By-law may be cited as the "F. J.
