

CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 608

A BY-LAW to authorise the Corporation of the District of Burnaby to acquire an Easement for Corporate purposes.

WHEREAS it is desirable and expedient that an Easement should be acquired through Lots One (1), Two (2) and Three (3), of Block Thirty seven (37) District Lot One hundred and fifty three (153) Group One (1) District of New Westminster Map No. 2069, for the purpose of a right of way for a sewer.

AND WHEREAS Bert Louis Krause and Elisa Krause, wife of Bert Louis Krause, both of 2790 Cassie Avenue, in the Municipality of Burnaby, are the owners in fee of Lot One (1) Block Thirty seven (37) District Lot One hundred and fifty-three (153), Group One (1).

AND WHEREAS Elisa Krause, wife of Bert Louis Krause, of 2790 Cassie Avenue, in the Municipality of Burnaby, is the owner in fee of Lots Two (2) and Three (3) of Block Thirty-seven (37) District Lot One hundred and fifty three (153) Group One (1).

AND WHEREAS under the provisions of paragraph (a) of sub-section 30. of Section 54, of the Municipal Act the Municipal Council is authorised to make and pass a By-law to acquire or accept easements.

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:-

(1). It shall be lawful for the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby to acquire an Easement from Bert Louis Krause and Elisa Krause, wife of Bert Louis Krause, both of 2790 Cassie Avenue in the Municipality of Burnaby, for a right of way for a sewer across a portion of Lot One (1), Block Thirty seven (37) District Lot One hundred and fifty three (153) Group One (1) Map 2069, New Westminster District, which parcel may be more particularly

described as follows:

Commencing at the South westerly corner of Lot One (1) Block 37, District Lot 153; thence Easterly and following the southerly boundary of said Lot 1, 66' more or less, to the South Easterly corner of said Lot 1, thence Northerly and following the Easterly boundary of said Lot 1, 10' more or less, to a line parallel to, and distant 10' from the Southerly boundary of said Lot 1; thence Westerly and following said parallel line, 66', more or less, to the Westerly boundary of said Lot 1; thence Southerly and following said Westerly boundary, 10', more or less, to the point of commencement, as shown coloured in red on the plan hereunto annexed,

paying therefor the sum of Twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars of lawful money of Canada.

(2). It shall be lawful for the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby to acquire an Easement from Elisa Krause, wife of Bert Louis Krause, of 2790 Cassie Avenue, in the Municipality of Burnaby, for a right of way for a sewer across a portion of Lots Two (2) and Three (3), Block Thirty seven (37) District Lot One hundred and fifty three (153) Group One (1) Map 2069, New Westminster District, which parcel may be more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the South Westerly corner of Lot 2, Block 37, District Lot 153; thence Easterly and following the Southerly boundary of Lots 2 and 3, 132 feet, more or less, to the South easterly corner of said Lot 3; thence Northerly and following the Easterly boundary of said Lot 3, 10 feet, more or less, to a line parallel to and distant 10 feet from the Southerly boundary of said Lots 2 and 3; thence Westerly and following said parallel line, 132 feet, more or less, to the Westerly boundary of said Lot 2; thence Southerly and following the said Westerly boundary 10 feet, more or less, to the point of commencement, as shown coloured red on the plan hereunto annexed.

paying therefore the sum of Twenty five (\$25.00) dollars of lawful money of Canada.

(3). This By-law may be cited as the "BURNABY EASEMENT BY-LAW 1927"
