

Burnaby Pole Line Road By-Law 1905. No. 61.
Amendment By-Law 1907.

A By-Law to amend the Burnaby By-Law
1905 ^{Pole Line}

Whereas a clerical error was made in the survey of the Burnaby Pole Line with respect to the description of the location of the said road through District Lots numbered 96 and 92.

And whereas it is both necessary and expedient that said error should be corrected

Be it therefore enacted by the Municipal Council of Burnaby pursuant to the provisions of the "Municipal Clauses" Act and amending acts:

1. Section 1. paragraph "Re lot 96" of the said By-Law is hereby amended by striking out the figures "1763" in the seventh line thereof, and inserting in lieu thereof the figures "1719".

2. Section 1. paragraph "Re lot 96" of the said By-Law is hereby amended by striking out the figures "1763" in the fourth line thereof, and inserting in lieu thereof the figures "1719".

3. This By-Law may be cited for all purposes as the "Burnaby Pole Line Road By-Law 1905, amendment By-Law 1907."
