

A By-Saw

for resuming certain Land in District Sot 85 Group I New Westminster District for making and establishing a Road.

Whereas by the "Municipal Clauses Act" certain powers are conferred on the Councils of Townships or District Municipalities to resume any part of lands granted by the Crown for making roads or other works of public utility or convenience, so nevertheless that the entire acreage of the lands resumed, or to be resumed, shall not exceed one twentieth part of the whole of the lands granted as aforesaid all as therein set forth.

Be it therefore enacted by the Reeve and Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby in open Council assembled;


That the Council hereby resumes the lands and premises hereinafter described being situate in District Sot Eighty-five (85) Group I New Westminster District for the purpose of making and establishing a road to be named, and known as "Beach Road," namely Commencing at a post set on the West Boundary of the British Columbia Electric Railway Company's (otherwise the Vancouver Power Company's) Pole Line Road in Sot 85 Group I New Westminster District 13.05 chains North (true) from its intersection with the South boundary of said Sot 85 Group I thence West (true) 4.30 chains more or less to the shore of Deer Lake, the above described line to be the centre line of highway 66 (sixty-six) feet in width.

This By-Saw may be cited for all purposes as the Burnaby Beach Road Appropriation By-Saw 1907.

Passed the First and Second Readings
on the Eighteenth day of May 1907.

Reconsidered read a Third time and
finally passed by the Council in open
session assembled assembled this First
day of June. In the year of Our
Lord One thousand nine hundred and
seventy.
