

CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 633

A BY-LAW to amend "The Burnaby Plumbing By-law
1926."

The Municipal Council of the Corporation of the
District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:-

1. Sub-section 15 of Section 46 of the said "The
Burnaby Plumbing By-law 1926" is hereby amended by
inserting before the word "In" in the first line thereof
the words "Subject to the proviso to Sub-section 18 of
this Section."

2. Section 46 of the said "The Burnaby Plumbing
By-law 1926" is hereby amended by adding to Sub-section
18 thereof the following: "Provided that subject to the
approval of the Medical Health Officer a building may be
occupied as a residence if it shall have installed
appurtenant thereto, an approved dry earth closet, or
an approved covered sanitary bucket."

3. Sub-section 4 of Section 52 of the said "The
Burnaby Plumbing By-law 1926" is hereby repealed and the
following substituted therefor:-

(4) "All Water closets shall be provided with a
sufficient supply of water for flushing to keep the same
in a proper clean condition and shall be so constructed
as to permit of their being shut off without any inter-
ference with any other fixtures."

4. This By-law may be cited for all purposes as
"The Burnaby Plumbing By-law 1926 Amendment By-law 1927"
