BURNABY ROAD TAX BY-LAW, 1908.

WHEREAS by Sub-Section (118) of Section 50 of the "Municipal
Clauses Act 1906" as amended by Section 9 of the "Municipal
Clauses Act Amendment Act 1908", power is given to the Council of
a District Municipality to levy and collect Road Tax:

AND WHEREAS it is expedient that Road Tax shall be levied and
collected in the District of Burnaby:

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the District of Burnaby
enacts as follows:-

1. On every male between the ages of twenty-one and sixty
residing for two weeks within the Municipality of Burnaby whose
name is not entered on the Assessment Roll of the District,
there is hereby levied for every year and there shall be collected
a Road Tax of Two Dollars, which amount shall be paid to the person
duly authorized by the Council to collect the same.

2. For the collection and recovery of the said tax the provisions
of the "Municipal Clauses Act 1906" and Amendments shall apply and
be used.

3. This By-Law shall take effect from the date of signing
thereof.

4. The Burnaby Road Tax By-Law, 1901 is hereby repealed.

5. This by-law may be cited for all purposes as the "Burnaby
Road Tax By-Law, 1908."

BURNABY ROAD TAX BY-LAW, 1908.

WHEREAS by Subsection (118) of Section 50 of the " Municipal
Clauses Act 1906 " as amended by Section 9 of the
" Municipal Clauses Act Amendment Act 1908 ", power is
given to the Council of a District Municipality to levy
and collect Road Tax.

AND WHEREAS it is expedient that Road Tax shall be levied
and collected in the District of Burnaby:

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the District of Burnaby
enacts as follows;-

1. ON EVERY MALE between the ages of twenty-one and sixty
residing for two weeks within the Municipality of Burnaby
whose name is not entered on the Assessment Roll of the District
there is hereby levied for every year and there shall be
collected a Road Tax of Two Dollars, which amount shall be paid
to the person duly authorized by the Council to collect the
same.

2. FOR THE COLLECTION and recovery of the said tax the
provisions of the " Municipal Clauses Act 1906 " and
Amendments shall apply and be used.

3. THIS BY-LAW shall take effect from the date of signing
thereof.

4. THE BURNABY ROAD TAX BY-LAW, 1901 is hereby repealed.

5. THIS BY-LAW may be cited for all purposes as the
" Burnaby Road Tax By-Law, 1908."
