

A By-Law. #65

To regulate the placing of poles and wires on public highways  
in the Municipality of Burnaby.

---

WHEREAS by Section 4 of the Municipal Clauses Act Amendment Act 1908 in every municipality the Municipal Council may, from time to time, make, alter and repeal by-laws to regulate the placing of poles and wires, to regulate the replacing of poles upon construction of permanent side walks or permanent work, notwithstanding anything contained in any special or private Act.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township or District of Burnaby as follows:-

1. Before proceeding to place poles or wires on any public highway within the said Municipality or to replace any poles already placed upon any such highway every telephone, telegraph, electric light or power company whether operating under special or private acts or otherwise, shall file with the clerk of the municipality an application for a permit therefore and such application shall be accompanied by plans and specifications of the work proposed to be done giving the size and kind of poles and wires proposed to be so placed or replaced upon such highway and the positions in which the same are to be erected or strung, and no company shall proceed with any such work without receiving a permit from the Municipal Council of the said Municipality to proceed with such work.
2. This By-Law may be cited as "The Poles and Wires Regulation By/Law 1908".

Passed the first and second readings by the Council on the 4th. day of May 1908.

Reconsidered, adopted and finally passed by the Council the 5<sup>th</sup> day of May 1908.
