

CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 684

A By-law to amend "LOCAL IMPROVEMENT  
CONSTRUCTION BY-LAW NO. 12, 1927".

WHEREAS the work authorized in "Local Improvement  
Construction By-law No. 12, 1927" has been carried out in  
part that is to say, from Eton Street to Montrose Street.

AND WHEREAS it is deemed inadvisable and impracticable  
to complete the work as undertaken owing to the excessive  
grade between Edinburgh Street and Montrose Street.

AND WHEREAS the special assessment roll with respect  
to the work undertaken has not been made and confirmed as  
provided by the Local Improvement Act.

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of  
the District of Burnaby, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

1. Paragraph One (1) of the "Local Improvement Construction  
By-law No. 12, 1927" is hereby repealed and the following is  
substituted therefor as paragraph One (1):-

"1. That a four (4) foot cement concrete sidewalk be con-  
structed on the East side of Boundary Road, from Eton  
Street to Edinburgh Street as a local improvement under  
the provisions of the "Local Improvement Act"."

2. This By-law may be cited as "LOCAL IMPROVEMENT CON-  
STRUCTION BY-LAW NO. 12, 1927, AMENDMENT BY-LAW 1928".
