

CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 690.

A BY-LAW fixing the annual indemnity payable to the Reeve and Councillors.

WHEREAS by sub-section 9 of Section 54 of the "Municipal Act" of the Revised Statutes of British Columbia, A.D. 1924 as amended by the "Municipal Act Amendment Act 1928" it is provided that the Council may from time to time make, alter, and repeal by-laws for indemnifying the Reeve and Councillors by a sum of money out of the annual revenue to each in respect of their attendance at meetings of the Council and Committees subject to the limitations in said sub-section mentioned.

THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

1. The Reeve of the said Corporation shall be paid an annual indemnity of Two Thousand (\$2000.00) Dollars and the Councillors of the said Corporation shall be paid an annual indemnity of Five hundred (\$500.00) Dollars each, such indemnities to be payable monthly on the first day of each month, subject however to the fines and deductions for non-attendance mentioned in the succeeding section hereof.

2. If the Reeve or any Councillor should absent himself without leave of the Council from any meeting of the Council a fine of Five (\$5.00) Dollars shall be imposed on such Reeve or Councillor for each and every meeting not attended and if the Reeve or any Councillor should absente himself without leave from any committee meeting a fine of Two Dollars and Fifty cents (\$2.50) shall be imposed upon such absentee for each and every meeting not attended, such fines to be deducted from the indemnity payable under the preceding section hereof. Provided that in all cases where reasons satisfactory to the Council are given for such non-attendance the Council may by


resolution remit such fines in which case no deduction shall be made for or on account of same.


3. The "Burnaby Indemnity By-law 1915" is hereby repealed.

4. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY INDEMNITY BY-LAW 1928"


