A By-Law

To provide for the Annual Return of the Assessment Roll
Be it enacted by the Reeve and Council of the Corporation of
the District of Burnaby, in Council assembled as follows:

1. The Assessor shall on each year, between the 1st day of
February and 1st day of March, make up an assessment Roll
for the year on basis of the "Municipal Act 1892" and shall
return the same to the Council on the 1st day of March
in each year.

2. For the purpose of rating all the land and
land occupied by Railways and Tramways within the District
shall be estimated at its actual Cash value as it would
be appraised in payment of a just debt from a dishonest
debtor, but without placing any value or importance of
any kind affected in said land by the owner or his partners
other in title, or any addition to the value of the land
in respect of improvements so made.

3. For the purpose of ascertaining the actual value of
the land in the District, the Assessor shall set down on a
Separate Column in the Assessment Roll an estimate of the
value of all improvements made upon the said lands, the amount of the
value of such improvements being the difference between the actual
cash value of the land as improved as it would be appraised
as aforesaid, and the value subscribed for land unimproved
as aforesaid. Before returning the said Assessment Roll to the Council
the Assessor shall have noted on the town and at works
by the State, and such other local sites both the
assessments of the land for taxation proposed and the
