

CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY.

BY-LAW NO. 701.

A By-law to authorize the payment of certain sums to poor persons within the Municipality of Burnaby.

WHEREAS Mary Amelia Reid Kennedy of Number 501 Nineteenth Avenue in the Municipality of Burnaby, Province of British Columbia, Wife of Alexander Kennedy, deceased, and Kate Chesley, of Number 485 Tenth Avenue in the Municipality of Burnaby, Province aforesaid, wife of Philip Thomas Chesley, deceased, are poor persons under the provisions of sub-section 41 of section 54 and section 464 of the Municipal Act of the Statutes of British Columbia;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed advisable to make provision for the said Mary Amelia Reid Kennedy and Kate Chesley;

AND WHEREAS the said Mary Amelia Reid Kennedy and Kate Chesley have conveyed to the Corporation of the District of Burnaby certain lands and premises on certain terms and conditions which said terms and conditions are the terms set out in the undertakings hereinafter referred to;

THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

1. Authority is hereby given to the Reeve and Clerk of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby to sign, execute and affix the Corporate Seal to and give delivery to Mary Amelia Reid Kennedy of an Indenture or Undertaking in favour of the said Mary Amelia Reid Kennedy all to the extent on the terms and in the manner set forth in the said Indenture a copy of which is hereto annexed and that all as an act and deed of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby.

2. Authority is hereby given to the Reeve and Clerk of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby to sign, execute and affix the Corporate Seal to and give delivery to Kate Chesley of an Indenture or Undertaking in favour of the said Kate Chesley all to the extent on the terms and in the manner set forth in the said Indenture a copy of which is hereto annexed and that all as an act and deed of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby.

3. This By-law may be cited as the "KENNEDY-CHESLEY UNDERTAKING BY-LAW 1928".

WITNESSETH, that whereas one Mary Amelia Reid Kennedy, of Number 501 Nineteenth Avenue, in the Municipality of Burnaby, Province of British Columbia, Widow, is a poor and destitute person within the meaning of sub-section 41 of section 54 and section 464 of the Municipal Act, Chapter 179 of the Revised Statutes of British Columbia, 1924.

AND WHEREAS, the said Mary Amelia Reid Kennedy hath conveyed to the Corporation of the District of Burnaby certain lands and premises, namely:

ALL AND SINGULAR that certain parcel or tract of land and premises situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby in the Province of British Columbia, more particularly known and described as: Part of Lot Twenty-four (24) of the North Part of Lot Twenty-eight (28), Group One (1), Map 632, shown outlined in Red and Lettered "A" on sketch deposited No. 3203; AND South Easterly Half of Lot Twenty-five (25) of Lot Twenty-eight (28) Group One (1), Map 632, said ^{east} south/half being all that part of said Lot having a frontage on Nineteenth Avenue of 65.46 feet by half the full depth of said Lot.

THE Corporation of the District of Burnaby hereby undertakes and agrees, for and in consideration of the said conveyance and for the purpose of fulfilling its obligations and duties under section 464 of the Municipal Act aforesaid to pay to the said Mary Amelia Reid Kennedy

the sum of Twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars on the First (1st) day of each and every month during the lifetime of the said Mary Amelia Reid Kennedy, provided that if the said Mary Amelia Reid Kennedy, becomes an inmate of a Hospital the Corporation of the District of Burnaby shall pay the charges for care and treatment therein and shall not be liable to pay during such time, the said sum of Twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars per month.

THE Corporation of the District of Burnaby further undertakes and agrees and doth hereby grant unto the said Mary Amelia Reid Kennedy a tenancy for her lifetime of the premises described as Part of Lot Twenty-four (24) of the North Part of Lot Twenty-eight (28), Group One (1), Map 632, shewn outlined in Red and Lettered "A" on sketch deposited No. 3203; AND South Easterly Half of Lot Twenty-five (25) of Lot Twenty-eight (28), Group One (1), Map 632, said South East Half being all that part of said Lot having a frontage on Nineteenth Avenue of 65.46 feet by half the full depth of said Lot, in the Municipality of Burnaby.

ALL AND SINGULAR that certain parcel or tract of land and premises situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby in the Province of British Columbia, more particularly known and described as Lots Thirty-three (33) and Thirth-four (34) Block Three (3), District Lot Thirteen (13), Group One (1), Map 3046, formerly known as Lot Thirty-three (33) of Block Three (3) of Lot Thirteen (13) Group One (1), Map 1794;

THE Corporation of the District of Burnaby hereby undertakes and agrees, for and in consideration of the said conveyance and for the purpose of fulfilling its obligations and duties under section 464 of the Municipal Act aforesaid to pay to the said Kate Chesley the sum of Twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars on the First (1st) day of each and every month during the lifetime of the said Kate Chesley, provided that if the said Kate Chesley becomes an inmate of a Hospital the Corporation of the District of

Burnaby shall pay the charges for care and treatment therein and shall not be liable to pay during such time, the said sum of Twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars per month.

THE Corporation of the District of Burnaby further undertakes and agrees and doth hereby grant unto the said Kate Chesley a tenancy for her lifetime of the premises described as Lots Thirty-three (33) and Thirty-four (34) Block Three (3), District Lot Thirteen (13), Group One (1), Map 3046, formerly known as Lot Thirty-three (33) of Block Three (3) of Lot Thirteen (13) Group One (1), Map 1794, in the Municipality of Burnaby.
