

CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY.

BY-LAW NO. 704.

A BY-LAW TO amend the "Burnaby Sewer Connections Regulation By-law 1926".

THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

1. Section Two (2) of the Burnaby Sewer Connections Regulation By-law 1926, being By-law No. 535 of the Corporation as amended by By-law No. 537, intituled the "Burnaby Sewer Connections Regulation By-law 1926, Amendment By-law 1926" and as further amended by By-law No. 549 intituled the "Burnaby Sewer Connections Regulation By-law 1926, Amendment By-law No. 2, 1926" is hereby repealed and the following substituted therefor:

"2. Before any such connection is made, application must be made by the owner, to the Municipal Engineer in the form of "Schedule A" of this By-law and there shall be paid with each application a fee of Twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars."

2. This By-law shall take effect upon the day and date of registration hereof.

3. This By-law may be cited as the "Burnaby Sewer Connections Regulation By-law, 1926, Amendment By-law 1928".
