

CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY.

BY-LAW NO. 709.

A BY-LAW to amend the "Burnaby Plumbing By-law 1926.

THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:-

1. Section 9 of the Burnaby Plumbing By-law 1926 being By-law No. 542 of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby, is hereby repealed and the following substituted therefor:-

9. The fee or fees hereinafter specified, shall be payable to the Municipal Treasurer by all applicants for permits, and the same shall be payable in advance.

For every fixture to be installed, or for which provision of waste or vent is made:

For the first 5 fixtures, 50¢ per fixture.

For each succeeding fixtures, 75¢ per fixture. The charge of 75¢ per fixture shall also apply to any work of remodelling or alteration; but no permit shall be issued for a less fee than \$1.00.

When work is found to be defective or not ready for inspection at the time specified in notice, a further notice for inspection must be filed, together with a fee of \$1.00 to cover cost of extra inspection.

2. This By-law may be cited as the "BURNABY PLUMBING BY-LAW 1926 AMENDMENT BY-LAW 1928."


