##-LAW #0. 751.

A By-law to authorize the construction of a six (6) foot coment concrete sidewalk on the Borth side of Hastings Street from the West boundary of Let Thirteen (13), to the Bast boundary of Let Eleven (11), in Block Six (6), District Let 116, as a Local Improvement under the provisions of the "Local Improvement Act".

WHERAS Barnet Lumber Company Limited and others have petitione the Council to construct, as a week of local improvement, the work hereinafter described and the Clerk has certified that the petition is sufficient, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the petiti in the number hereinafter provided;

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Distr

- 1. That a six (6) foot cement comprete sidewalk be constructed on the North side of Eastings Street from the West boundary of Let Thirteen (13), to the East boundary of Let Eleven (11), in Block Eix (6), B.L. 116, as a local improvement under the provisions of the "Local Improvement Let",
- 2. The Engineer of the Corporation do Drinwith make such plan profiles, and specifications and farmish such information as may be necessary for the making of a contract Dr the execution of the work.
- 3. The work shall be carried on and executed under the superintendence and according to the directions and orders of such Engine
- 4. The Reeve and Clerk are authorised to cause a contract for the construction of the work to be made and entered into with some person or persons, firm or corporation, subject to the approval of this Genneil to be declared by resolution; Provided that the Council in its discretion may by resolution determine that the construction of the work or any part thereof shall be done by the Municipality instead of by contract. In the event of the work or my part thereof being undertaken by the Municipality a separate account shall be kept by the Treasurer of all expenditures in connection therewith.
 - 5. The Treasurer may, subject to the approval of the Council?

agree with any bank or person for temperary advances of money to meet the seet of the work pending the completion of it.

- 6. The special assessment shall be paid by ten (10) annual instalments.
- 7. The debentures to be issued for the loan to be effected to pay for the east of the work when completed shall bear interestat five (5%) per cent per amount and be made payable within ten (10) years on the sinking fund plan and in settling the sum to be raised amountly to pay the debt the rate of interest on investments shall not be estimated at more than four (4%) per cent per amount.
- 8. Any person whose lot is specially assessed may commute for a payment in each the special rates imposed thereon, by paying the pertion of the cost of construction assessed upon such lot, without the interest ferthwith after the special assessment roll has been certified by the Clerk, and at any time thereafter by the payment of such sum as when invested at not more than four (4%) per cent per annum will provide an annuity sufficient to pay the special rates for the unexpired pertion of the terms as they fall due.
- 9. This Ry-law may be sited as "LOCAL IMPROVEMENT CONSTRUCTION BY-LAW NO. 28, 1928".
