

CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO 760.

A By-law to further amend "Burnaby Trades License By-law 1927".

The Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

1. Schedule "A" of said "Burnaby Trades License By-law 1927" as re-enacted by Section 1 of "Burnaby Trades License By-law 1927, Amendment By-law No. 2, 1928" is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following:-

"60. - From every person carrying on the trade, occupation or business of barber, hairdresser, milliner, dressmaking, optician, photographer, art and photo supply dealer, boot and shoe repairer, cleaner and dyer, tailor, watchmaker, - \$1.00 for every six months."

2. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY TRADES LICENSE BY-LAW 1927, AMENDMENT BY-LAW NO. 3, 1928".
