

CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 773.

A By-law to authorise the payment of a certain sum to a poor person within the Municipality of Burnaby.

WHEREAS Margaret Jane Patton of Number 4248 Keefer Street in the Municipality of Burnaby, Province of British Columbia, wife of Albert Patton, deceased, is a poor person under the provisions of sub-section 41 of section 54 and section 464 of the Municipal Act of the Statutes of British Columbia;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed advisable to make provision for the said Margaret Jane Patton:

AND WHEREAS there has been conveyed to the Corporation of the District of Burnaby all the lands in which the said Margaret Jane Patton has an interest:

THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

1. Authority is hereby given to the Reeve and Clerk of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby to sign, execute and affix the Corporate Seal to and give delivery to Margaret Jane Patton of an Indenture or Undertaking in favour of the said Margaret Jane Patton all to the extent on the terms and in the manner set forth in the said Indenture a copy of which is hereto annexed and that all as an act and deed of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby.

2. This By-law may be cited as the "MARGARET JANE PATTON UNDERTAKING BY-LAW 1928."

CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY.

THIS INSTRUMENT made the Seventeenth (17th) day
of September A.D. 1928.

WITNESSETH, that whereas one Margaret Jane Patton of
Number 4248 Keefer Street, in the Municipality of Burnaby,
Province of British Columbia, Widow, is a poor and destitute
person within the meaning of sub-section 41 of section 54 and
section 464 of the Municipal Act, Chapter 179 of the Revised
Statutes of British Columbia, 1924.

AND WHEREAS there has been conveyed to the Corporation
of the District of Burnaby all the lands in which the said
Margaret Jane Patton has an interest, namely:

ALL AND SINGULAR that certain parcel or tract of land
and premises situate, lying and being in the Municipality of
Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia more particularly
known and described as Lots Seven (7) and Eight (8), Block
Eighteen (18) District Lot 121, Group One (1) Map 1054.

The Corporation of the District of Burnaby hereby
undertakes and agrees for the purpose of fulfilling its
obligations and duties under section 464 of the Municipal
Act aforesaid to pay to the said Margaret Jane Patton the sum
of Twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars on the First (1st) day of
each and every month during the lifetime of the said Margaret
Jane Patton, provided that if the said Margaret Jane Patton
becomes an inmate of a hospital the Corporation of the
District of Burnaby shall pay the charges for care and
treatment therein and shall not be liable to pay during
such time, the said sum of Twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars
per month.

The Corporation of the District of Burnaby further under-

takes and agrees and doth hereby grant unto the said Margaret Jane Patton a tenancy for her lifetime of the premises described as Lots Seven (7) and Eight (8), Block Eighteen (18), District Lot 121, Group One (1) Map 1054.
