

CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO.828



A By-law for charging against and collecting from owners of houses situate on lands not abutting directly thereon for the use of public sewers.

WHEREAS the Corporation of the District of Burnaby has constructed or acquired certain public sewer systems in the Municipality of Burnaby:

AND WHEREAS the owners of certain houses situate on lands not abutting directly on such sewers have applied for and have been granted permission to connect with the said sewers and are not paying any rent, rates or charges for the use thereof:

AND WHEREAS it is desirable that such owners as well as other owners who may, subsequent to the passage of this by-law, obtain sewer connections for their houses under similar conditions be charged a rent for the use of the said sewers:

THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

1. There shall be charged against and collected from the owners of each and every house in the Municipality of Burnaby situate on lands not abutting directly on any public sewer heretofore or hereafter constructed or acquired by the Corporation of the District of Burnaby in the said Municipality and who have heretofore obtained or may hereafter obtain permission from the Corporation to connect with the said sewers an annual sewer rent computed at the rate of Fifteen Cents per foot of the width of the parcel or parcels of land on which their houses respectively are situate.

2. The said sewer rent shall be payable on the First day of

January in each and every year during the existence of the said connections, provided that the said rent shall terminate when the said lands respectively shall be assessed for or on account of any sewer system constructed for the purpose of serving such lands.

3. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY SEWER RENTAL BY-LAW 1929".
