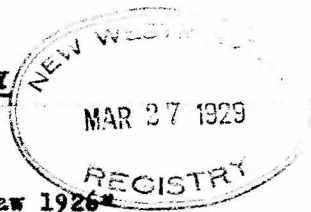


CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY



BY-LAW NO. 837.

A By-law to amend the "Burnaby Building By-law 1926"

THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby hereby enacts as follows:-

1. The "Burnaby Building By-law 1926" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following Sections:-

"340a" No person shall erect or maintain a sign which projects over any street or sidewalk unless and until he shall have deposited with the Clerk of the Municipality a Bond of Indemnity satisfactory to the Council indemnifying the Corporation against all loss, costs, damages and expenses which the Corporation may suffer be put to or be at by reason or on account of any claim or demand or any action or suit which may be made upon or brought against the Corporation by reason or on account of the erection or maintenance of any such projecting sign; and no such projecting sign shall be maintained over any street or sidewalk for a longer period than the life of the Bond of Indemnity so deposited in respect thereof or any renewal or renewals thereof."

"340b All signs projecting over any street or sidewalk shall be illuminated from one hour after sunset until eleven o'clock in the evening of every day".

2. This by-law may be cited as the "Burnaby Building By-law 1926, Amendment By-law 1929".
