#### Abstract

A BY-LAW to authorize the construction of a four (4') foot oment ooncrete sidewalk on the South side of Dundes Street from Esmand Avenue to Ingleton Avenue and upon the Bast side of Esmond Avenue from Dundas Street to Lane South of Dundes Streat, as a Local Improvement under the proviaions of the "Local Improvement Aot."


WHERTBAS Alex. MaArthur and others have petitioned the Cound1 to construct, as a work of local improvement, the work hereinafter described and the Clerk has oertified that the petition ia suffiaient and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the petition in the manner hereinafter provided.

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Distriot of Burneby ENACIS AS FOLLOWS:-

1. That a four (4') foot oement concrete sidewalk be construeted on the South side of Dunde gtreet from Hamond Avenue to Ingleton Avenue and upon the Last side of Esmond Avenue fram Dundas Street to Lane South of Dundas Street, as a Loeal improvement under the provisions of the "Local Improvement Act."
2. The Engineer of the Corporation do forthwith make suah plans, profiles, and specifications and furnish such information as may be necessary for the making of a contract for the executian of the work.
3. The work shail be carried on and executed under the superintendence and according to the directions and orders of such lingineer.


#### Abstract

4. The Reeve and Clerk are autharised to cause a contract for the construction of the work to be made and ontered into with some person or persons, firm or corporetion, subject to the approval of this Council to be declared by resolution; Provided that the Council in its discretion may by resolution determine that the construation of the work or any part thereof shall be done by the Municipality instead


of by contract. In the event of the work or any part thereof being undertaken by the Municipality a separate acount shall be kept by the Treasurer of all expenditures in connection therewith.
5. The Ireasurer may, subject to the approval of the Council agree with any bank or person for temporary advances of money to meet the cost of the worl pending the completion of it.
6. The special assessment shall be paid by ter (10) annual instalments.
7. The debentures to be issued for the loen to be effected to pay for the cost of the work when completed shall bear interest at ( $5 \%$ ) per cent. per annum and be made payable within (10) years on the sinking fund plan and in setting the sum to be raised annually to pay the debt the rate of interest on investments shall not be estimatea at more than four ( $4 \%$ ) per cent per annum.
8. Any person wose lot is specially assessed may commute for a payment in cash the special retes imposed thereon, by paying the portion of the cost of construction assessed upon such lot, without the interest forthwith after the special assessment roll has been certified by the Clerk, and at any time thereafter by the payment of such sum as when invested at not more than four ( $4 \%$ ) per cent per annum will provide an annuity sufficient to pay the speciel rates for the unexpired portion of the terms as they fall due.
9. This By-law may be oited as "LOCal Improvimint CONSTRUCTION BY-LAN NO. 15. 1929."
