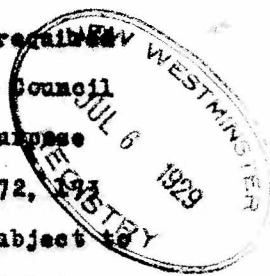


CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 910.

A BY-LAW to expropriate certain lands in the Municipality of Burnaby for the purpose of widening Marine Drive.

WHEREAS the lands hereinafter mentioned are required for the purpose of widening Marine Drive, and the Council has determined to expropriate the same for such purpose pursuant to the provisions of sub-sections 171, 172, and 212 of Section 54 of the Municipal act, but subject to the restrictions contained in Part XIV of the said Act.



THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby hereby enacts as follows:-

1. For the purpose of widening Marine Drive in the Municipality of Burnaby the lands hereinafter described are hereby expropriated and shall be entered upon, taken and used:-

ALL AND SINGULAR, that certain parcel or tract or land and premises situate, lying and being a portion of Lot 7, Block 2, District Lot 173, Group 1, District of New Westminster, Province of British Columbia, according to Map No. 1034, deposited, and being more particularly described as follows:-

COMMENCING at the Southeasterly corner of Lot 7, aforesaid; thence N 61° 47' W. and following the Northeasterly Boundary of said Lot 7, 484.0 feet to the East Northerly corner thereof; thence S. 50° 31' W. and following the Northwesterly Boundary of said Lot 7, 10.80 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 61° 48' E. 86.83 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 6° 41' E. 57.11 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 61° 47' E. 76.85 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 86° 08' E. 121.27 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 61° 47' E. 182.17 feet to an iron pin set on the Southeasterly boundary of Lot 7, aforesaid; thence N. 50° 33' E. and following the said Southeasterly Boundary of Lot 7, 10.81 feet to the point of commencement and containing, by admeasurement, 0.278 of an acre, be the same more or less as shown on the plan hereunto annexed and thereon outlined with red colour.

2. The said lands and premises hereby expropriated shall immediately after this By-law has been brought into effect, pursuant to the provisions of said sub-section 212, be entered upon, taken and used by the Corporation for all the purposes for which they are hereby expropriated.

3. Any real property injuriously affected by the carrying

out of the work of widening the said highway and the expropriations therefor may be entered upon by the workmen and employees of the Corporation or of any contractor employed to carry out such work and they are hereby authorized so to enter to execute any works of construction, maintenance or repair in mitigation of injury done or apprehended or in reduction of compensation claimable by reason of or through the carrying out of the said work.

4. This By-law shall come into effect when it has been published and registered in the Land Registry Office for the District in which said lands are situate as required by the provisions of said sub-section 212 of Section 54 of the "Municipal Act."

5. This By-law may be cited as the "Marine Drive Expropriation By-law 1929."

DONE AND PASSED in Open Council this Twenty fourth (24th) day of June, A.D. 1929.
