BY-LAW NO. 914

BY-LAW to amend the "Local Improvement Debenture Consolidation By-law 1928."

- - - - -

WHEREAS the Burnaby Local Improvement Debenture Consolidation By-law 1928 was finally passed on the 25th day of June, 1928;

AND WHEREAS it is desirable that the places of payment of principal and interest of the Debentures authorized by the said By-law should be changed;

AND WHEREAS the dates of payment of Interest on the Debentures authorized by the said By-law are in error;

AND WHEREAS the Debentures authorized by the said By-law have not been sold.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:-

1. Section 3. of By-law No. 743 entitled the "Local Improvement Debenture Consolidation By-law 1928" is hereby repealed and the following substituted therefor:

5. The said debentures shall be payable on the Thirtieth day of June, 1928, at any office of the Royal Bank of Canada in the Province of British Columbia, or at the principal office of the Royal Bank of Canada in the Cities of Edmonton or Calgary in the Province of Alberta, or in the City of Winnipeg in the Province of Manitoba, or in the City of Toronto in the Province of Ontario or in the Cities of Montreal or Quebec in the Province of Quebec, and shall bear interest at the rate of Five (5%) per cent. per annum payable half yearly on the Thirtieth day of June and the Thirty first day of December in each and every year and the debentures shall have attached to them coupons for the payment of interest, which said Coupons shall be payable at any office of the Royal Bank of Canada in the Province of British Columbia, or at the principal office of the Royal Bank of Canada in the Cities of Edmonton or Calgary in the Province of Alberta, or in the City of Winnipeg in

the Province of Manitoba, or in the City of Toronto, in the Province of Ontario, or in the Cities of Montreal or Quebec in the Province of Quebec.

4. This By-law shall take effect upon receiving the assent of the Lieutenant Governor in Council.

5. This By-law may be cited as "Local Improvement Debenture Consolidation By-law 1928, Amendment By-law 1929."

6. DONE AND PASSED in Open Council this Seventeenth (17th) day of June, A.D. 1929.

7. RECONSIDERED AND FINALLY PASSED this Twenty fourth (24th) day of June, A.D. 1929.
