

By-law No. 93.

A By-law to Appoint a Police Magistrate for the Municipality
of Burnaby

WHEREAS it is expedient to appoint a Police Magistrate for the
Municipality of Burnaby under the authority of Section 211
of the "Municipal Clauses Act."

The Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District
of Burnaby enacts as follows:-

1. That Benjamin George Walker, Esq., J. P.
of the Municipality of Burnaby, one of His Majesty's Justices
of the Peace in and for Province of British Columbia, be and
he is hereby appointed to be Police Magistrate for the Municipality
of Burnaby for the term of 1911 or at the pleasure of the Council.
The remuneration payable to such Police Magistrate shall be the
Statutory Court fees payable in pursuance of the Statute.

2. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY POLICE MAGISTRATE
APPOINTMENT BY-LAW 1911."
