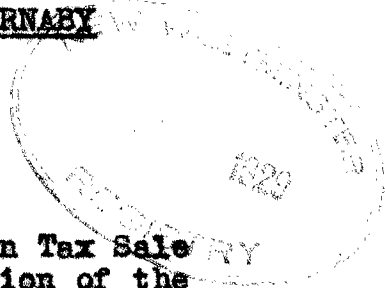


CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 956.



A BY-LAW to authorize the sale of certain Tax Sale lands belonging to the Corporation of the District of Burnaby.

WHEREAS at the Tax Sales held by the Collector of Burnaby for the years 1916, 1917, 1919, 1920, 1922, 1926, 1927 and 1928 the lands described in the Schedules marked "A", "B", "C", "D", "E", "F", "G" and "H" hereto annexed became the property of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby in default of other purchaser.

AND WHEREAS the person named in the several Schedules Marked "A", "B", "C", "D", "E", "F" "G" and "H" hereto annexed has offered to purchase the lands set opposite his name in the said Schedules for the price named therein, AND it is advisable to accept the said offers, respectively.

THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby therefore enacts as follows:-

1. That the parcel of land set opposite the name of the purchaser in the several Schedules marked "A", "B", "C", "D", "E", "F", "G", and "H" hereto annexed, which Schedules are hereby incorporated with and made part of this by-law, be sold and disposed of to the person named in the said Schedules as purchaser thereof for the consideration therein expressed.

2. That upon payment of the consideration named in the said Schedules for the parcel of land sold, conveyance to the purchaser named in the said Schedules be executed under the seal of the Corporation by the Reeve and Clerk and delivered to the purchaser.

3. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY LAND SALE BY-LAW, No. 10, 1929."

DONE AND PASSED in Open Council this Twenty-third (23rd) day of September, A.D. 1929.

RECONSIDERED AND FINALLY PASSED by a three-fourths majority of all the members of the Municipal Council on the Seventh (7th) day of October, A.D. 1929.

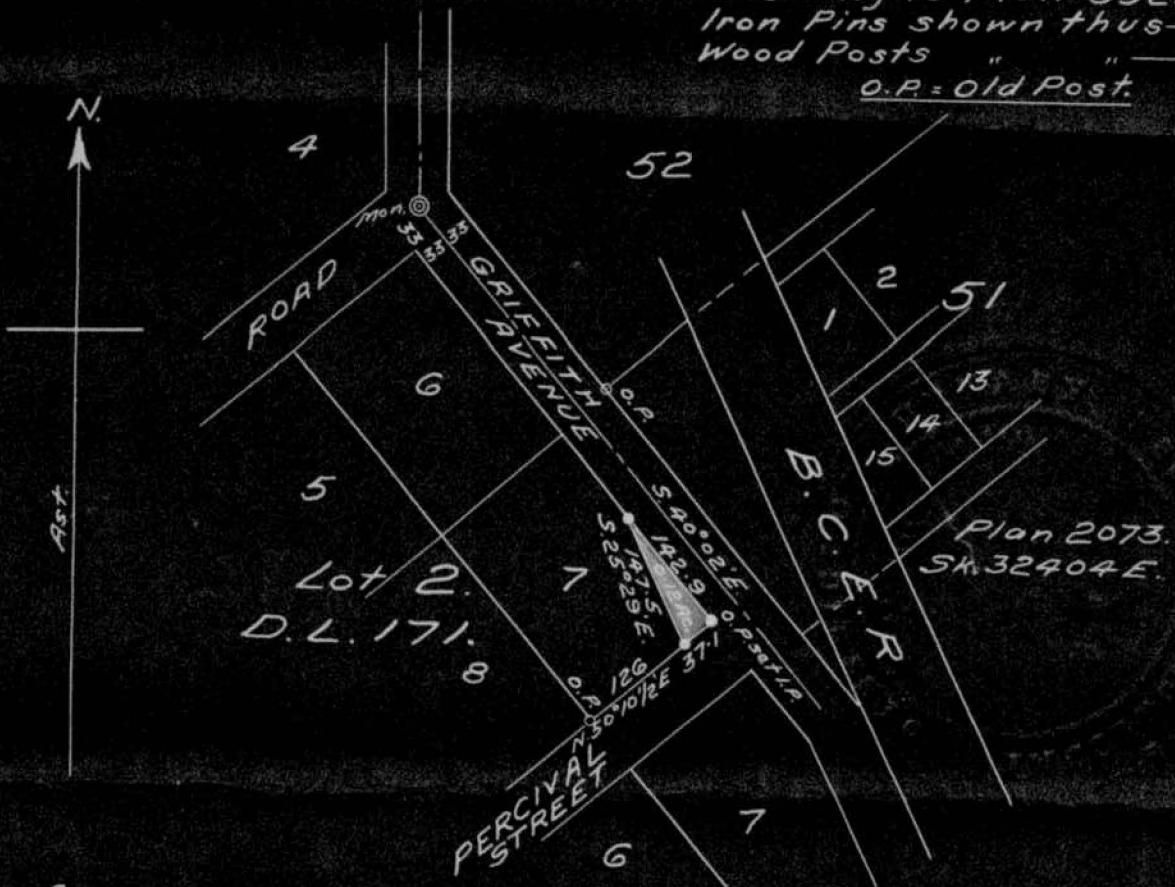
