CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF HURNABY

BY-LAW NO.967

A BY-LAW to authorize the Corporation of the District of Burnaby to acquire Easements for Corporate purposes.

WHEREAS it is desirable and expedient that Easements should be acquired through the hereinafter described property for the purpose of rights of way for drainage ditches.

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AND WHEREAS Robert Percy Clark (Broker) of

805 Hastings Street West, in the City of Vancouver is the owner of Lot 28, Subdivision 7 of Elocks 5 to 9 inclusive, D.L. 96, Group 1. New Westminster District Map No. 1194:

AND WHEREAS George Henry Wilson (Physician) of 2706 Nelson Avenue, in the Municipality of Burnaby, Province of British Columbia, is the owner of Elock 18, D.L. 99. Group 1. New Westminster District, Map No. 844.

AND WHEREAS the aforesaid Robert Percy Clark, and the aforesaid George Henry Wilson, have agreed to grant an easement for a right of way over and through their respective properties;

AND WHEREAS under the provisions of paragraph (2) of sub-section 30 of Section 54 of the Municipal Act the Municipal Council is authorised to make and pass by-laws to acquire or accept casements.

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:-

(1) It shall be lawful for the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby to acquire an Easement from Robert Percy Clark, Broker, of 805 Hastings Street West, in the City of Vancouver, Province of British Columbia, for a right of way for a drainage ditch across a

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portion of Lot Twenty eight (28) Block Seven (7) of Blocks Five (5) to Nine (9) inclusive. District Lot Ninety six (96) Group One (1) New Westminster District. which parcel may be more particularly described as follows:

COMMENCING at the Northeast corner of Lot 28, aforesaid; thence Westwardly and following the North Boundary of said Lot 28, 8.0 feet

thence Southwardly and parallel to the East Boundary of Lot 28, aforesaid, 120.0 feet, more or less, to a point on the South Boundary thereof; thence Eastwardly and following the South Boundary of Lot 28, aforesaid, 8.0 feet to the Southeast corner thereof;

thence Northwardly and following the East Boundary of Lot 28, aforesaid, 120 feet to the point of commencement as shown on the plan hereinto annexed and thereon outlined with red colour.

paying therefor the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar of lawful money of Canada.

(2) It shall be lawful for the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby to acquire an

easement from George Henry Wilson, Physician, of 2706 Nelson Avenue in the Municipality of Burnaby, Province of British Columbia, for a right of way for a drainage ditch across a portion of Block Eighteen (18) District Lot Ninety nine (99) Group One (1) New Westminster District, Map No. 844. which parcel may be more particularly described as follows:

COMMENCING at a point on the East boundary of Elock 18, aforesaid, 343.8 feet, 8 0°13' E. from the Northeast corner of said Block 18;

thence S. 88° 24' W. 372.21 feet to an iron pin set on the East boundary of Maple Avenue at a point 357.0 feet S. 0° 13' E. from the North boundary of said Block 18;

thence S. 0° 13' E. and following the East boundary
of Maple Avenue, 10.0 feet to a post;
 thence N.88° 24' E., 372.38 feet to a post set on
the East boundary of Elock 18, aforesaid;
 thence N. 0° 13' W., 10.0 feet to the point of
commencement and containing, by admeasurement 0.085 of an
acre be the same more or less as shown on the plan here? acre, be the same more or less, as shown on the plan hereunto annexed and thereon outlined with red colour:

paying therefor the sum of One (\$1.00) dollar of lawful money of Canada.

(3) This By-law may be cited as the "Barnaby Easement Authorization By-law 1929."
