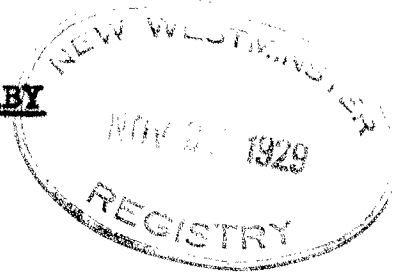


CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 987.



A BY-LAW to authorize the Corporation of the District of Burnaby to sub-lease Lot 4898, Group 1, New Westminster District.

WHEREAS Lot "E" District Lot 173, Group 1, New Westminster District was acquired by the Corporation of the District of Burnaby at the Tax sale held by the Collector for the year 1918 in default of other purchaser.

AND WHEREAS the said Lot "E" was leased to E. C. Phillips Lumber Company Limited by an indenture dated the Fifth (5th) day of February, 1923.

AND WHEREAS the said Lot "E" has been sold to Lillian Pollard, Stenographer, of the City of New Westminster together with all the benefits of the said lease.

AND WHEREAS the said lease included the sub-lease of Lot 4898, Group One (1), New Westminster District, from the Corporation to the E. C. Phillips Lumber Company Limited.

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby, ENACTS as follows:-

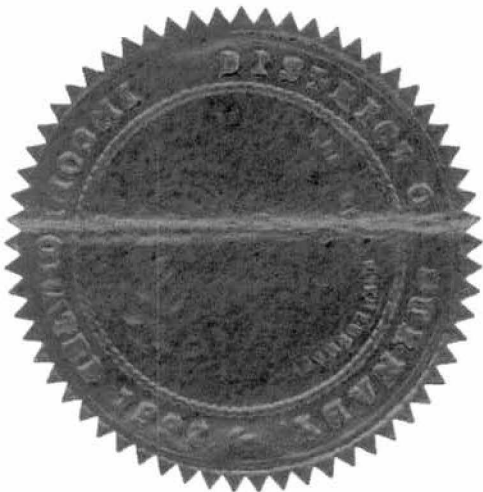
1. It shall be lawful for the Corporation to assign and set over to Lillian Pollard, Stenographer, of the City of New Westminster, Province of British Columbia, the purchaser of the said Lot "E", District Lot 173, Group One (1),

New Westminster District all of its right, title and interests in Lot 4898, Group One (1), New Westminster District subject to all of the terms conditions and provisions contained in the original lease of the said Lot 4898 from the Crown to the Corporation of the District of Burnaby.

2. This By-law may be cited as "Burnaby Foreshore Lease By-law 1929."
