

CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 995.

A BY-LAW to acquire lands within the Municipality of Burnaby for Park purposes.

- - - - -

WHEREAS under the provisions of sub-section 180 of Section 54 of the "Municipal Act" the Municipal Council is authorised to make and pass by-laws to acquire lands within or without the Municipal limits for the purpose of a public park.

AND WHEREAS it is desirable and expedient that Lot One (1), of Block Forty six (46) of District Lot Sixty-nine (69) Map No. 1321, Group One (1) New Westminster District, should be acquired for Park purposes.

AND WHEREAS Samuel Herbert Prentis (Tailor) and Caroline Naomi Leacock, (Widow), both of 1244 - 14th. Avenue in the Municipality of Burnaby are the owners of the said Lot One (1).

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby enacts as follows:©

1. That Lot One (1) Block Forty six (46) District Lot Sixty nine (69), Group One (1) New Westminster District, Map No. 1321 be acquired from Samuel Herbert Prentis and Caroline Naomi Leacock both of 1244 - 14th. Avenue, in the Municipality of Burnaby, for Park Purposes.
2. That upon execution and delivery of conveyance by the said Samuel Herbert Prentis and Caroline Naomi Leacock of the said Lot One (1), they shall be paid the sum of Three hundred and Twenty five (\$325.00) dollars.
3. There is hereby defined and set apart for park purposes all of the lands comprised in Lot One (1)

Block Forty six (46) District Lot Sixty nine (69)  
Group One (1) New Westminster District, Map No. 1321.

4. This By-law may be cited as "Broadview  
Park Land Acquisition and Dedication By-law 1929."
