

CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 1031.



A BY-LAW to authorize the Corporation of the District of Burnaby to acquire an Easement for Corporate purposes.

WHEREAS it is desirable and expedient that an Easement should be acquired for drainage purposes across the lands described as the Easterly Ten (10) feet of Lot Eight (8), Block One (1), District Lot Twenty-seven (27), Group One (1), District of New Westminster, Province of British Columbia according to plan No. 697 having a frontage of Ten (10) feet on Eleventh Avenue and extending with uniform width for the full depth of said Lot Eight (8).

AND WHEREAS Eliza Clarinda Walker is the owner in fee of the said lands;

AND WHEREAS under the provisions of Sub-section 27 of Section 54 of the "Municipal Act", the Municipal Council is authorized to make and pass a by-law to acquire lands;

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby enacts, as follows:-

1. It shall be lawful for the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby to acquire an Easement from Eliza Clarinda Walker, (Widow), of 246 - 11th. Avenue, New Westminster, B. C. for drainage purposes across a portion of the Easterly Ten (10) feet of Lot Eight (8), Block One (1), District Lot Twenty-seven (27), Group One (1), District of New Westminster, Province of British Columbia according to plan No. 697 having a frontage of Ten (10) feet on Eleventh Avenue

and extending with uniform width for the full depth of
said Lot Eight (8)

Paying therefor the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar of lawful
money of Canada.

2. This By-law may be cited as the "Walker Easement
Authorization By-law 1930."
