CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 1035.

A BY-LAW to enable the Corporation of the District of Burnaby to provide for all sums which may be required for the lawful purposes of the Municipality and for School Board purposes, for the year 1930.

WHEREAS it is necessary and expedient to pass a By-law for the above named purposes.

THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Act and Amending Acts ENACTS as follows:-

- 1. There shall be raised, levied and collected for the year 1930 upon the assessed value of all improved taxable real property in the said Municipality of Burnaby as shown upon the last revised Assessment Roll thereof, all improvements being exempt altogether, a tax of Sixty one (61) mills in the dollar for the following purposes:-
- (a) To provide for interest only on Twenty three thousand (\$25,000.00) dollars debentures and interest and sinking fund on One million, Nine hundred and sixty six thousand, Nine hundred and Eighty dollars and eighty three cents debentures issued by the said Municipality, eighteen and seventeen one hundredths (18.17) mills in the dollar to be called the "Municipal Loan Rate".
- (b) To provide for the general purposes of the Municipality twelve and twenty eight one-hundredths (12.28) mills in the dollar to be called the "GENERAL RATE."
- (c) To provide for the general purposes of the Board of School Trustees of Burnaby Twenty-three and Twenty two one-hundredths (23.22) mills in the dollar to be called the "SCHOOL RATE."

- (d) To provide for interest and sinking fund on Five hundred and Twenty-seven thousand, one hundred thirteen dollars and sixty seven cents (\$527,113.67) School Board debentures is sued by the Municipality, five and twelve one-hundredths (5.12) mills in the dollar to be called the "SCHOOL LOAN RATE".
- (e) To provide for the payment of the proportion of the estimate for 1930 of the Vancouver and Districts

 Joint Sewerage and Drainage Board, two and twenty one one-hundredths (2.21) mills in the dollar to be called the

 VVANCOUVER AND DISTRICTS JOINT SEWERAGE AND DRAINAGE RATE.
- 2. There shall be raised and collected for the year 1930 upon the assessed value of all taxable real property in Burnaby Ward 5 District Improvement Area as shewn upon the last revised assessment roll thereof, within the boundaries of the area created by By-law No. 565 of the Corporation, a tax of nine and fifty-five one hundredths (9.55) mills in the dollar for the following purposes:-
- (a) To provide for interest and sinking fund on One hundred and thirty one thousand (\$131,000.00) dollars debentures issued by the said Municipality, nine and fifty-five one hundredths (9.55) mills in the dollar to be called the "BURNABY DISTRICT IMPROVEMENT RATE."
- 3. There shall be raised, levied and collected for the year 1930 upon the assessed value of the land and upon fifty per centum of improvements in the Burnaby Fire Area No. 1. as shown by the last revised assessment roll thereof a tax of one and fifty-five one hundredths (1.55) mills in the dollar for the following purpose:
- (a) To provide for the bousing, maintenance and operation of the fire apparatus provided for the said Fire Area, one and fifty-five one hundredths (1.55) mills, in the dollar to be called the "BURNABY FIRE AREA

NO. 1. MAINTENANCE RATE."

- 4. There shall be raised, levied and collected for the year 1930 upon the assessed value of the land and upon (50%) fifty per centum of improvements in the District Improvement Ornemental Lighting area as shewn upon the last revised assessment roll thereof, within the boundaries of the area created by By-law No. 912 of the Corporation, a tax of Five and sixty-five one hundredths (5.65) mills in the dollar for the following purposes:-
- (a) To provide for interest and sinking fund on Ten thousand (\$10,000.00) Dollars debentures issued by the said Municipality, five and sixty five one hundredths mills &n the dollar to be called the "ORNAMENTAL LIGHTING RATE."
- 5. The said taxes shall be payable to the Collector at the Municipal Hall, Edmonds, in the said Municipality.
- 6. Provided, however, anything hereinbefore contained to the contrary notwithstanding the sum of One (\$1.00) dollar shall be the minimum texation upon any parcel of taxable land upon the assessment roll of the Municipality.
- 7. This By-law may be cited as the "BURNABY REVENUE BY-LAW. 1930."
