BY-LAW NO. 1036.



A BY-LAW to amend the "Burnaby Health By-law 1926"

The Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:-

1. Sub-section "G" of Section 2 of "Burnaby Health By-law 1926 Amendment By-law 1928" being By-law No. 711 of the Corporation is hereby repealed and the following substituted therefor:-

(g) Tourist Camps are for transients and no permanent tenants shall be permitted save and except such male persons as may from time to time be approved by the Medical Officer of Health and under such terms and conditions as the Medical Officer of Health may prescribe.

2. Sub-sections "O" and "Q" of Section 2 of the said By-law No. 711 are hereby repealed.

3. This By-law may be cited as "Burnaby Health By-law 1926 Amendment By-law 1930."
