

CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 1097



A BY-LAW to amend the "Burnaby Plumbing By-law 1926 being By-law No. 542 of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby.

- - - - -

THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:-

1. Section 35 of the Burnaby Plumbing By-law 1926 being By-law No. 542 of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby repealed and the following substituted therefor:

35. All cast iron pipe shall be true to line and bore and of uniform thickness and free from blow-holes, cracks or other construction defects.

All cast-iron pipes and fittings shall be coated at the factory while clean, with linseed oil containing only sufficient thinning ingredient so as to thoroughly penetrate the pores of such cast iron.

Such pipes and fittings shall, however, be given the added protection of pitch or asphaltum should the Plumbing Inspector in his opinion deem such protection necessary for house drains laid in filled ground.

2. This By-law may be cited as "Burnaby Plumbing By-law 1926 Amendment By-law 1930."
