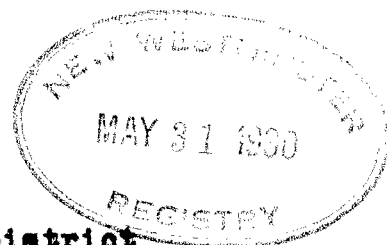


CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

By-law No. 1104.



A BY-LAW to enable the Corporation of the District of Burnaby to accept a conveyance of certain lands from Thomas Kirk and to grant to him a monthly allowance of Five (\$5.00) dollars in consideration therefor.

WHEREAS Thomas Kirk of the Municipality of Burnaby is a poor and destitute person.

AND WHEREAS pursuant to sub-section 41 of Section 54 of the Municipal Act the Council has power to pass a by-law to grant aid for the relief of the poor and pursuant to Section 464 of the said Act it is the duty of the Council to make suitable provision for its poor and destitute.

AND WHEREAS the said Thomas Kirk has offered to convey to the Corporation the lands and premises hereinafter mentioned in consideration of the Corporation assuming the cost of his maintenance in the Provincial Home for Incurables, and a monthly payment of Five (\$5.00) dollars to be made to him by the Corporation during the remainder of his lifetime and during the time he shall remain an indigent person.

AND WHEREAS the Council deems it expedient to accept the said offer and to enter into the agreement with the said Thomas Kirk hereinafter referred to.

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:-

1. The Corporation and its Council are hereby authorized and empowered to enter into an agreement with the said Thomas Kirk in the form of the draft set out in Schedule A hereto.
2. When the said agreement has been signed by the Corporation, and when the said Thomas Kirk shall have executed and delivered to the Corporation a deed in fee simple of the lands and premises described as Lot Nine (9) Block Two (2)

subdivision of southerly part of District Lot Twenty eight (28S) Group One (1) New Westminster District, Map No. 274 free and clear from all encumbrances whatsoever, the Treasurer of the Corporation is hereby authorized to pay to the said Thomas Kirk during the currency of the said agreement the monthly sum of Five (\$5.00) dollars, the first of such payments to be made on the 1st day of June, 1930, and all of such payments to be made subject to and in conformity with the terms and conditions of the said agreement.

3. This By-law may be cited as the "Thomas Kirk Land Acquisition and Undertaking By-law 1930."

DONE AND PASSED in Open Council this Nineteenth (19th) day of May, A.D. 1930.

RECONSIDERED and FINALLY PASSED this Twenty sixth (26th) day of May, A.D. 1930.

SCHEDULE "A"

THIS AGREEMENT made the 24th day of April, 1930.

BETWEEN

THOMAS KIRK of the Municipality of Burnaby  
Province of British Columbia, Labourer,  
hereinafter called the "First Party"

OF THE FIRST PART.

AND

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY  
hereinafter called the "Corporation"

OF THE SECOND PART.

WITNESSETH:

That whereas One Thomas Kirk, of 12th Avenue,  
in the Municipality of Burnaby, Labourer, is a poor and destitute  
person within the meaning of Section 464 of the Municipal Act,  
Chap. 179, R.S.B.C. 1924.

AND WHEREAS the said Thomas Kirk hath conveyed  
to the Corporation of the District of Burnaby, certain lands  
and premises, namely:-

Lot Nine (9) Block Two (2) subdivision of scatherly  
part of District Lot Twenty eight (28S) Group One (1) New  
Westminster District, Map No. 274.

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY hereby undertakes  
and agrees, for and in consideration of the said Conveyance to  
pay the cost of maintenance of the said Thomas Kirk at the  
Provincial Home for Incurable, Marpole, during his lifetime,  
and doth further undertake and agree to provide suitable  
funeral service on his demises

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY further  
undertakes and agrees to pay to the said Thomas Kirk, the sum  
of Five (\$5.00) dollars, of lawful money of Canada, on the  
First day of each and every month during the lifetime of the  
said Thomas Kirk.
