

CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 1183



A BY-LAW to define and set aside certain lands within the Municipality of Burnaby for Park purposes.

WHEREAS by paragraph "D" of sub-section 175 of Section 54 of the "Municipal Act" it is provided that in every Municipality the Council, may by by-law finally passed by a three-fourths vote of all the members thereof, and without obtaining the assent of the electors, define an area comprising lands that have become the property of the Municipality through tax sale proceedings and set aside such area for park purposes, for recreation grounds, or school sites, or for other public purposes.

AND WHEREAS it is considered expedient and in the public interest that the hereinafter mentioned lands in the Municipality of Burnaby should be so set aside.

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:-

1. There is hereby defined and set apart for park purposes all the lands comprised in the following, viz:-
  - (a) Lots One (1) to Thirty-six (36) inclusive, Block Twenty-nine (29) of District Lot One hundred and eighty seven (187) Group One (1) New Westminster District, according to Map Numbered 1282.
  - (b) Lot Twelve (12), Block Two (2), of District Lot Thirty (30), Group One (1) New Westminster District, Map Numbered 3036.
  - (c) West half Lot One ( $1W\frac{1}{2}$ ) and Lot Two (2) in Block Thirty two (32) District Lot Sixty-nine (69) Group One (1), according to Map Numbered 1321. Lots six (6) seven (7) and the west half of eight ( $8W\frac{1}{2}$ ) Block Thirty nine (39), District Lot sixty nine (69) Group One (1) New Westminster District, according to Map Numbered 1321. Lots One (1) and Twelve (12) of Block Thirty-three (33) District Lot Sixty nine (69) Group One (1) New Westminster District according to Map numbered 1321. Lot Twelve (12), Block Thirty-eight (38) District Lot Sixty-nine (69) Group One (1), New Westminster District, Map Numbered 1321.

2. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY PARK  
DEDICATION BY-LAW No. 2, 1930."
