

CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 1184.



A BY-LAW to enable the Corporation of the District of Burnaby to raise by way of loan the sum of One hundred and ninety five thousand (\$195,000.00) Dollars for road purposes.

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WHEREAS it is desirable and expedient that the Council of the said Corporation be authorized to borrow the sum of One hundred and ninety five thousand (\$195,000.00) dollars to provide for the construction and improvement of certain roads within the Municipality and the acquisition of property necessary for such construction and improvement, and the expropriation of such property if necessary.

AND WHEREAS an approximate estimate of the amount required for the proposed construction and improvements has been made by the Council as follows:-

Construction and Improvement of certain roads within the Municipality of Burnaby, the acquisition of property and expropriation thereof, if necessary, as set out in the schedule attached to and forming part of this By-law	\$190,000.00
Estimated costs incidental to this By-law and discount on debentures	<u>5,000.00</u>

AND WHEREAS it is necessary to raise the monies required to defray the above expenditure upon the credit of the Municipality.

AND WHEREAS the amount of the whole rateable land and improvements within the said Municipality according to the last revised assessment roll thereof is Twenty two million, two hundred and seventy eight thousand, eight hundred and fifty two dollars (\$22,278,852.00)

AND WHEREAS the existing total debt of the Municipality exclusive of the debt to be created by this By-law is Two million, seven hundred and eight thousand, six hundred and seventy five dollars and fifty cents (\$2,708,675.50) exclusive of local improvement debts secured by special rates or assessments of which none of the principal or interest is in arrear.

AND WHEREAS the amount of the debt which this By-law is intended to create is One hundred and ninety five thousand (\$195,000.00) dollars.

AND WHEREAS the estimated amount required to be raised annually for fifteen (15) years for the payment of the debt is Nine thousand, seven hundred and thirty nine dollars (\$9,739.00), and for paying the interest the sum of Nine thousand, seven hundred and fifty (\$9,750.00) dollars.

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

(1) It shall be lawful for the Council of the said Corporation to cause the said construction and improvements to be carried out, and the said property to be acquired, and expropriated, if necessary, all as set out in the schedule attached to and which shall form part of this By-law.

(2) It shall be lawful for the Reeve and Clerk of the said Municipality to raise by way of loan from any person or persons, body or bodies corporate who may be willing to advance the same upon the credit of the Corporation any sum or sums of money not exceeding in the whole the sum of One hundred and ninety five thousand (\$195,000.00) dollars and to issue debentures therefor in such sums as may be required being not less than One hundred (\$100.00) dollars each, and all such debentures shall be sealed with the seal of the Corporation, signed by the Reeve and countersigned by the Clerk thereof or by such other person or persons as

the Council may by resolution direct.

(3) The said debentures shall be payable on the Thirtieth (30th) day of September, 1945, at any office of the Royal Bank of Canada, in the Province of British Columbia, or at the principal office of the Royal Bank of Canada in the Cities of Edmonton or Calgary, in the Province of Alberta, or in the City of Winnipeg in the Province of Manitoba, or in the City of Toronto in the Province of Ontario, or in the Cities of Montreal or Quebec in the Province of Quebec, and shall bear interest at the rate of (5%) per centum, per annum, payable half yearly on the Thirty first day of March, and the Thirtieth day of September in each and every year and the debentures shall have attached to them coupons for the payment of interest which said coupons shall be payable at any office of the Royal Bank of Canada in the Province of British Columbia, or at the principal offices of the Royal Bank of Canada in the cities of Edmonton or Calgary in the Province of Alberta, or in the City of Winnipeg in the Province of Manitoba, or in the City of Toronto in the Province of Ontario, or in the Cities of Montreal or Quebec, in the Province of Quebec, and the signatures of the interest coupons may be either written, stamped, printed or lithographed.

(4) A special rate on the dollar shall be levied and raised in each year in addition to all other rates on all the rateable land or land and improvements in the Municipality of Burnaby sufficient to pay the interest upon the debentures and to create a sinking fund for the payment of the principal thereof when due, subject to any act or enactment respecting the same.

(5) Subject as aforesaid there shall be raised annually by special rate as aforesaid during the currency of the debentures, the sum of Nine thousand seven hundred and fifty (\$9,750.00) dollars for the payment of the interest thereon and the sum of Nine thousand, seven hundred

and thirty nine (\$9,739.00) dollars to provide a sinking fund for the payment of the principal.

(6) This By-law shall take effect upon registration thereof as provided by Section 178 of the Municipal Act and may be cited as "BURNABY MAJOR ROADS LOAN BY-LAW 1930."

(7) This By-law before the final passage thereof shall receive the assent of the electors of the said Municipality in the manner required by law.

DONE AND PASSED in Open Council this Twenty-ninth (29th) day of September, A.D. 1930.

RECEIVED THE ASSENT OF the Electors this Eighteenth (18th) day of October, A.D. 1930.
